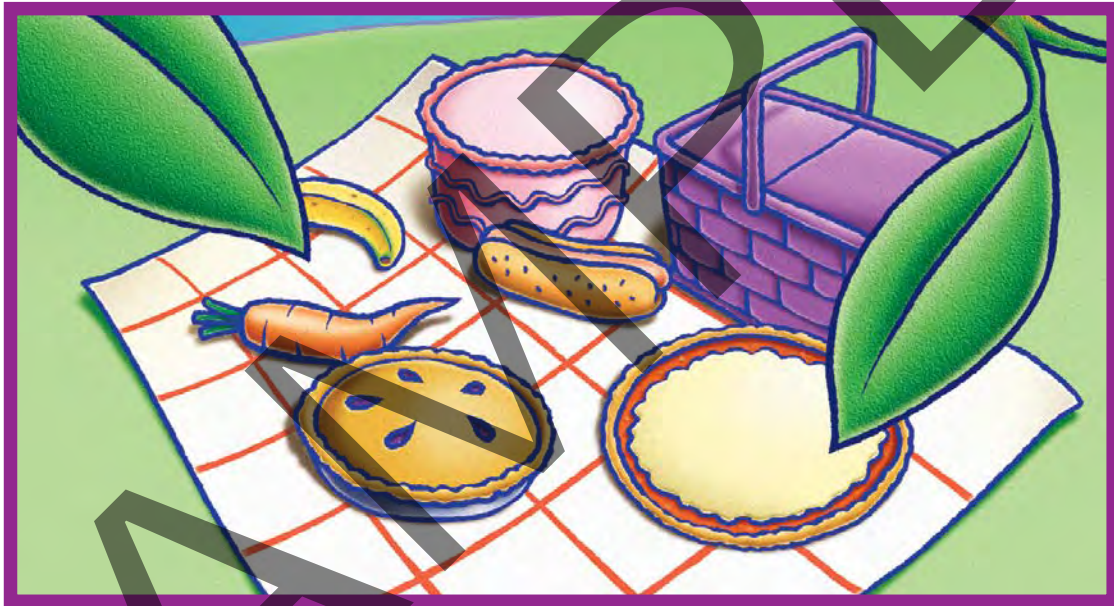


A Picnic

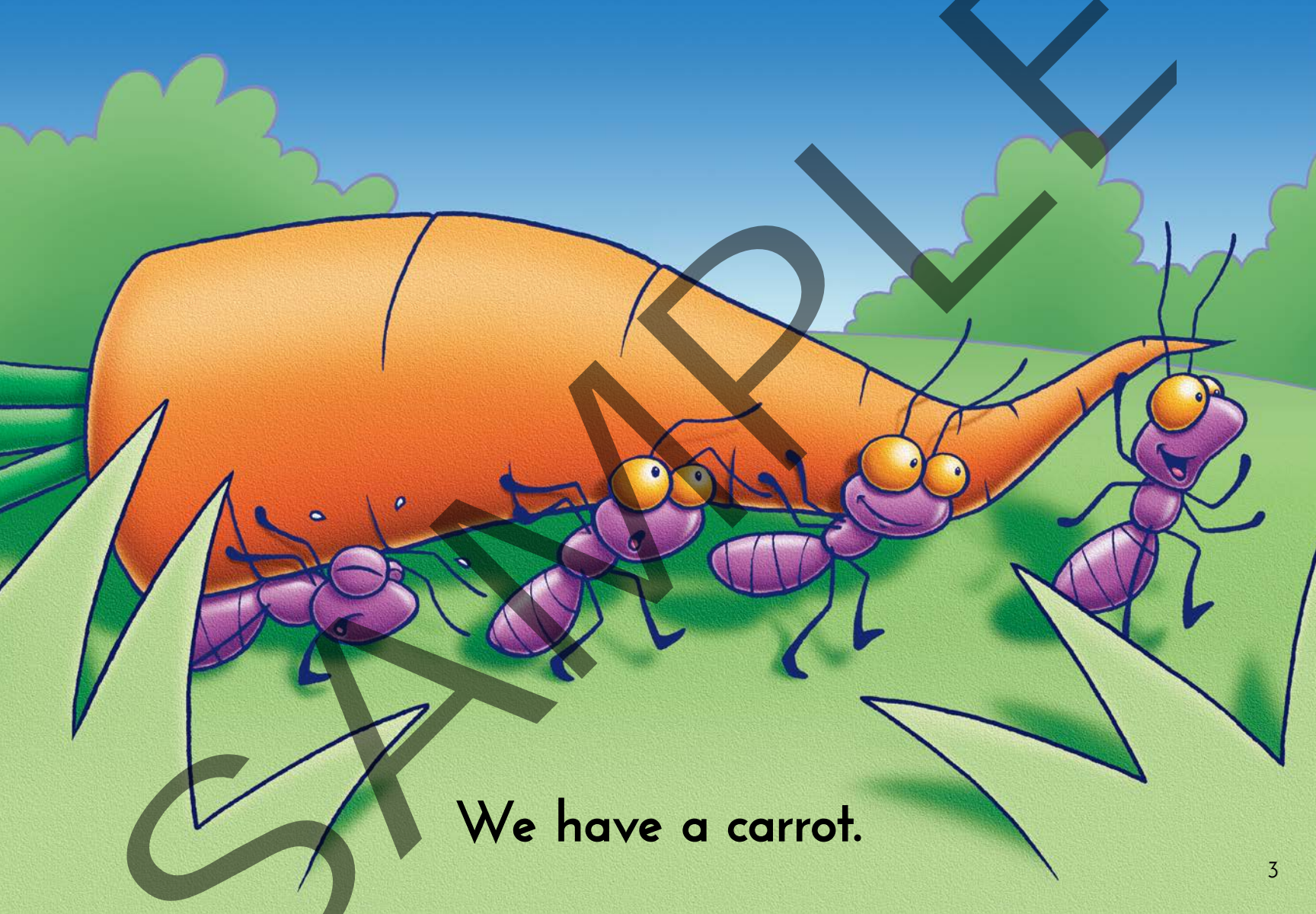
