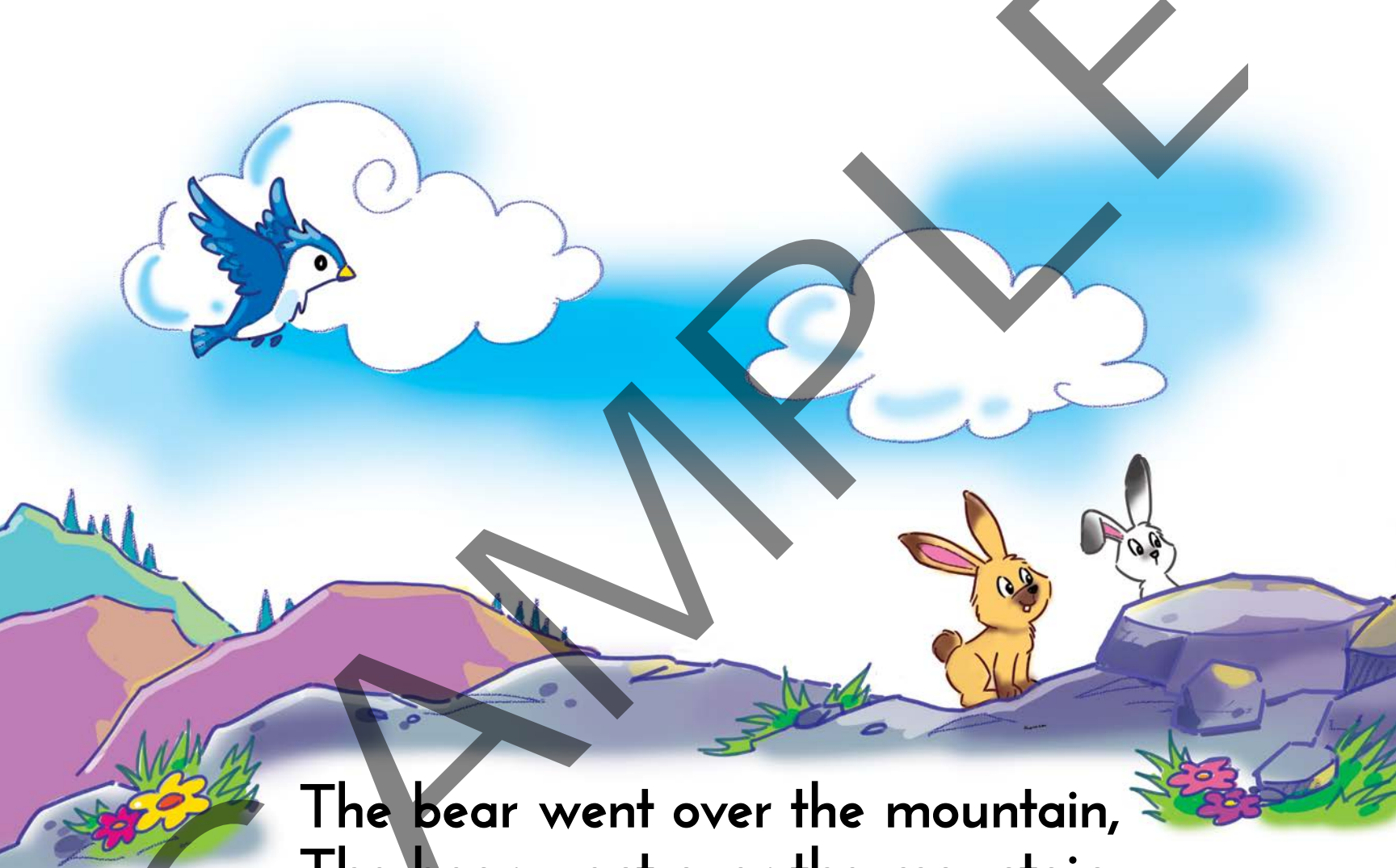


The Bear Went Over the Mountain
