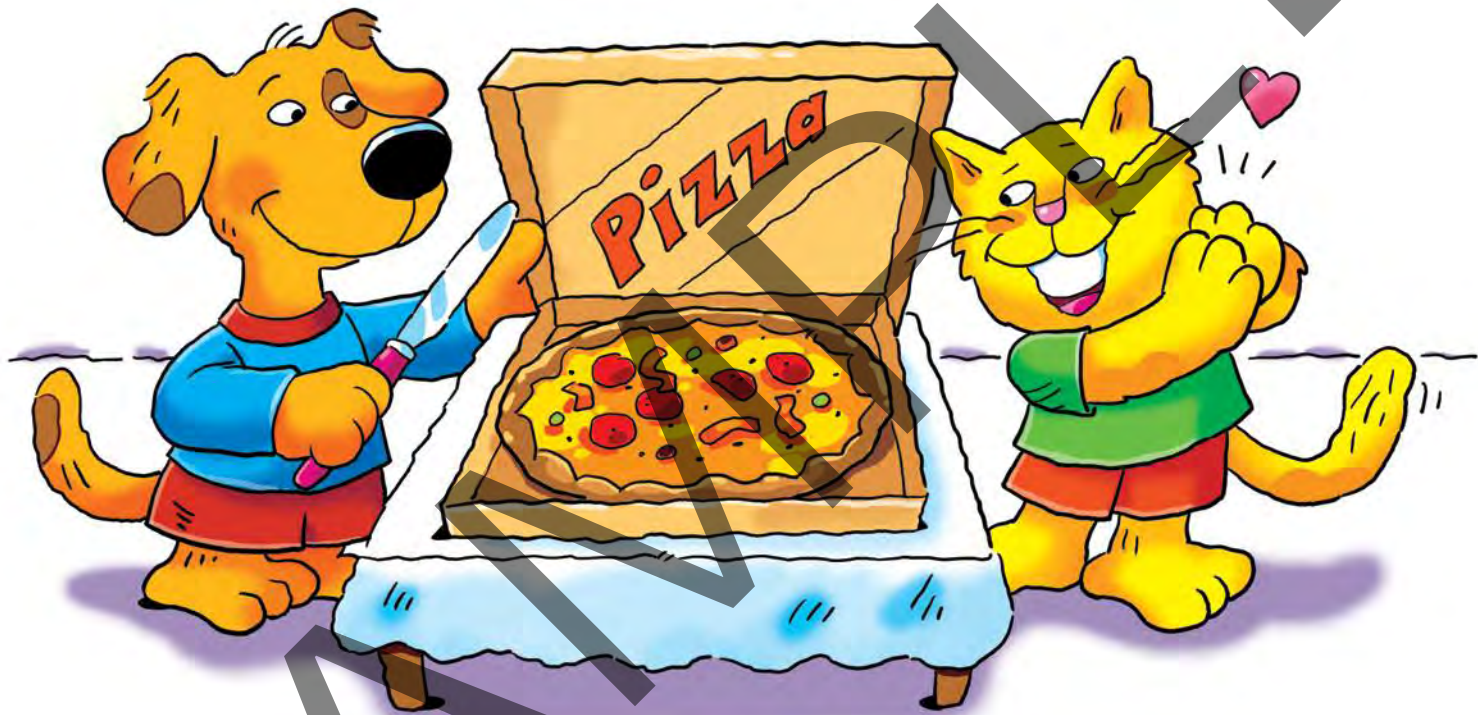


# Lunch with Cat and Dog

Why do you think Dog is winking?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Dog is winking because he tricked Cat.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Did Cat get more food than Dog?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> No. Dog divided the food up equally.</p>
