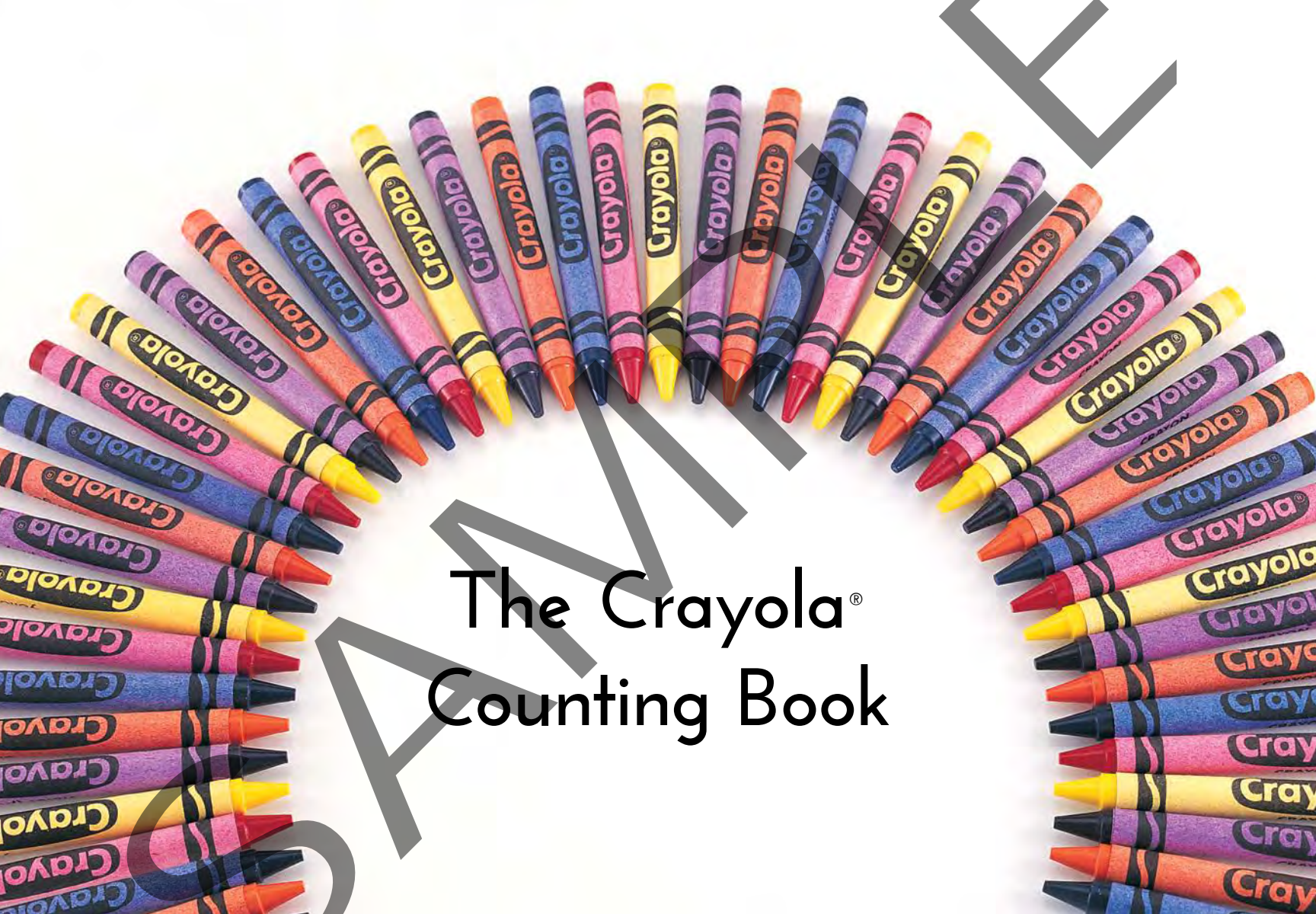


The Crayola® Counting Book

I like to draw and color my family.</p>	<p>Q1: What patterns do the crayons make on the title page and page 4?</p> <p>A1: On the title page, the repeated pattern is: orange, blue, red, yellow, purple, etc. On page 4, the repeated pattern is: red, blue, red, blue, . . .</p> <p>Q2: Let's look at pages 10 and 11. Let's count the crayons by tens.</p> <p>A2: Ten (10), twenty (20), thirty (30), forty (40), fifty (50), sixty (60), seventy (70), eighty (80), ninety (90), one hundred (100).</p>	<p>Q1: What is the best thing about crayons?</p> <p>A1: You can draw and color your own pictures.</p> <p>Q2: What did the children draw?</p> <p>A2: The children drew airplanes, whales, a puppy, a house, a dog riding a bike, colorful flowers, and a brown spotted cat. They also drew self-portraits.</p>
