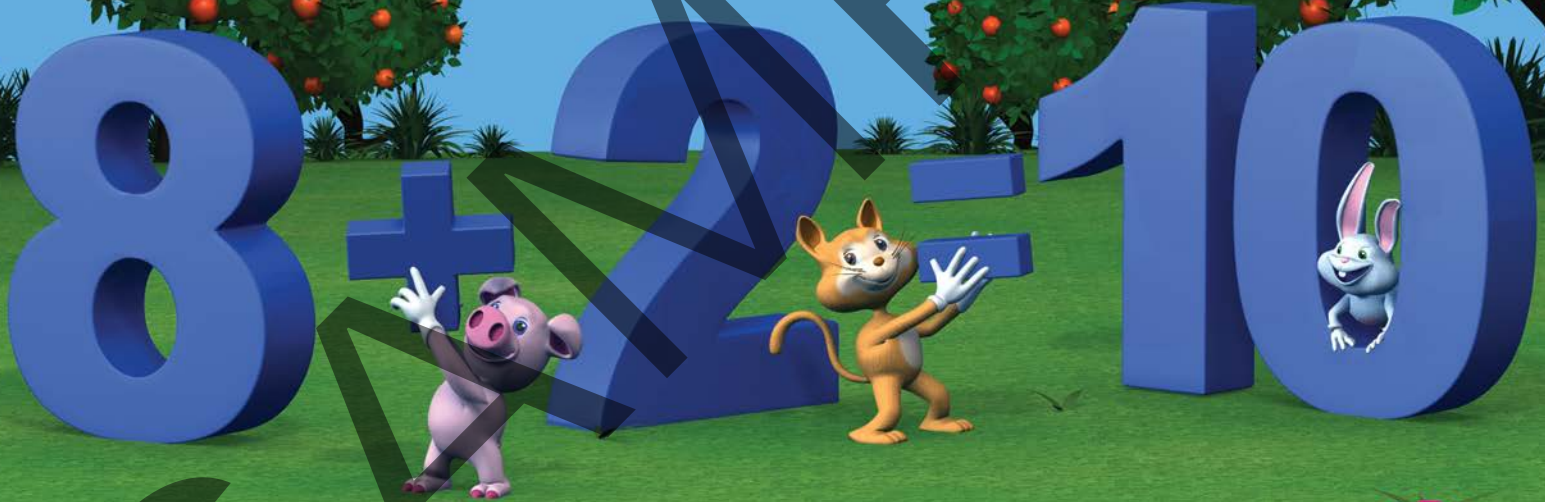


Little Number Stories-Addition

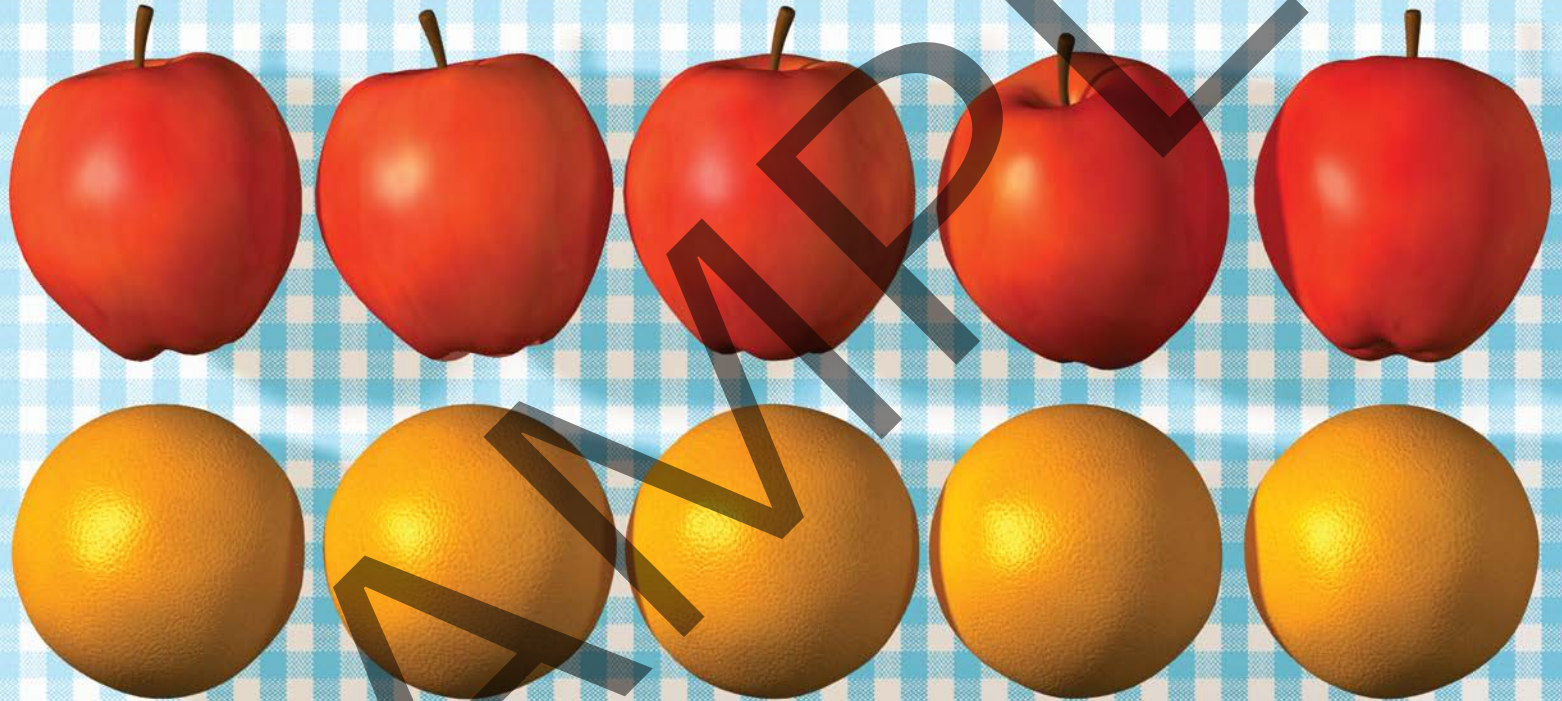
Before Reading	During Reading	After Reading
<p>Q1: Let's look at the cover. What do you see?</p> <p>A1: I see big red numbers: 2, 4, 6. I see a rabbit, a sheep, and a pig.</p> <p>Q2: Let's look at the title page. What do you see?</p> <p>A2: A pig, a cat, and a rabbit are making an addition number sentence: $8 + 2 = 10$.</p>	<p>Q1: The book is about adding different groups of numbers together to make ten. What are some numbers that add up to ten?</p> <p>A1: Possible answers: $5 + 5 = 10$; $6 + 4 = 10$; $5 + 3 + 2 = 10$</p> <p>Q2: Let's look at page 5. Will all the rabbits get a yummy treat?</p> <p>A2: Yes, there are ten rabbits and ten yummy treats. Each rabbit will get one yummy treat.</p>	<p>Q1: Let's look at pages 12-13. Can you count by ten to find the total number of items?</p> <p>A1: Yes, I can! 10, 20, 30, 40, 50!</p> <p>Q2: Let's look at page 13. If you add 10 more happy friends, how many happy friends will you have?</p> <p>A2: I will have 20 happy friends!</p>
