Can you describe the monster mess?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> There are cups and glasses on the floor. A chair is knocked over. The cookies and toys are on the floor too.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Does this story have a happy ending?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Yes, because the monsters and the little boy are having fun. The tea party is very messy, but the boy and the monsters are all smiling and dancing.</p>

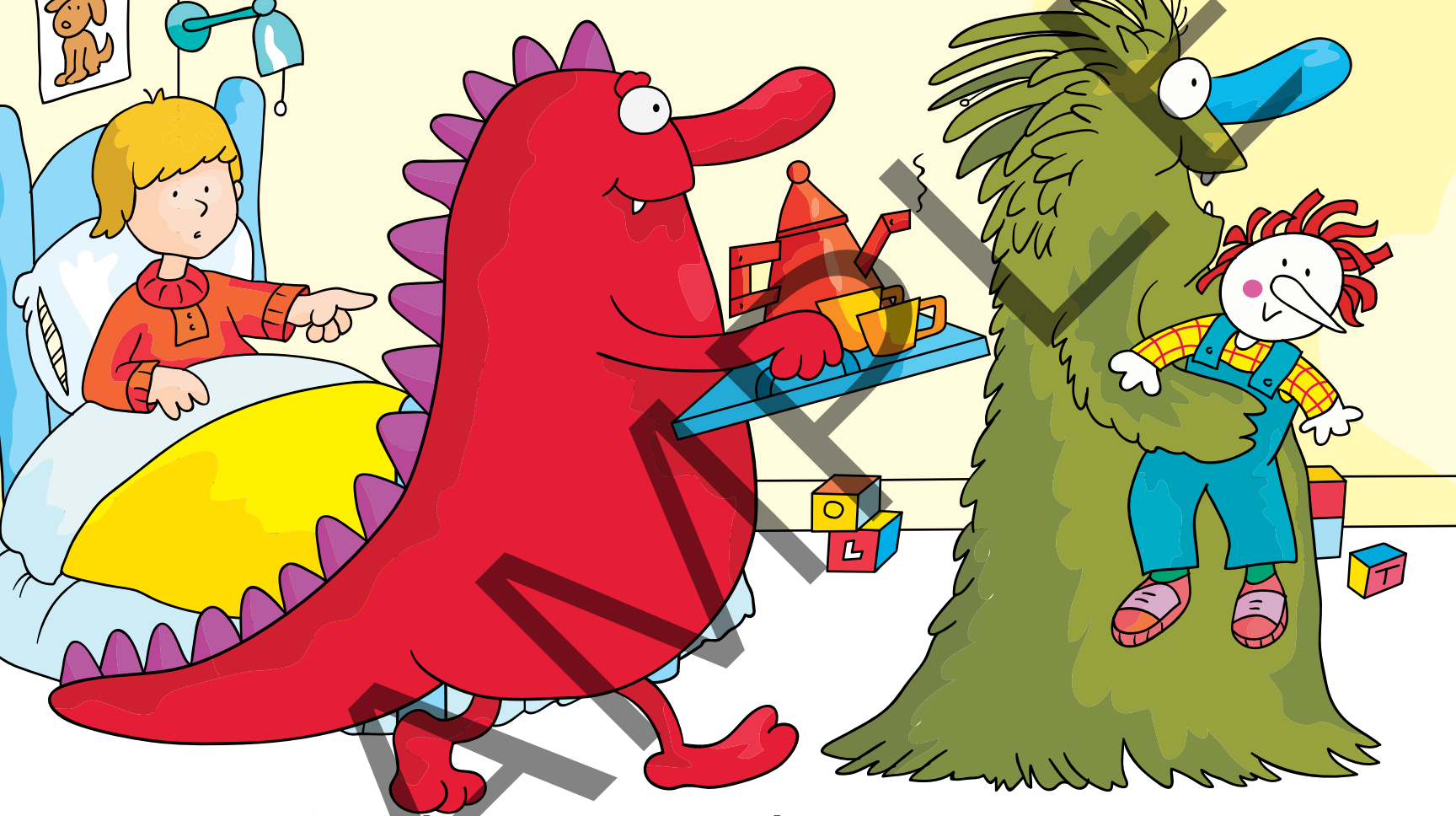
