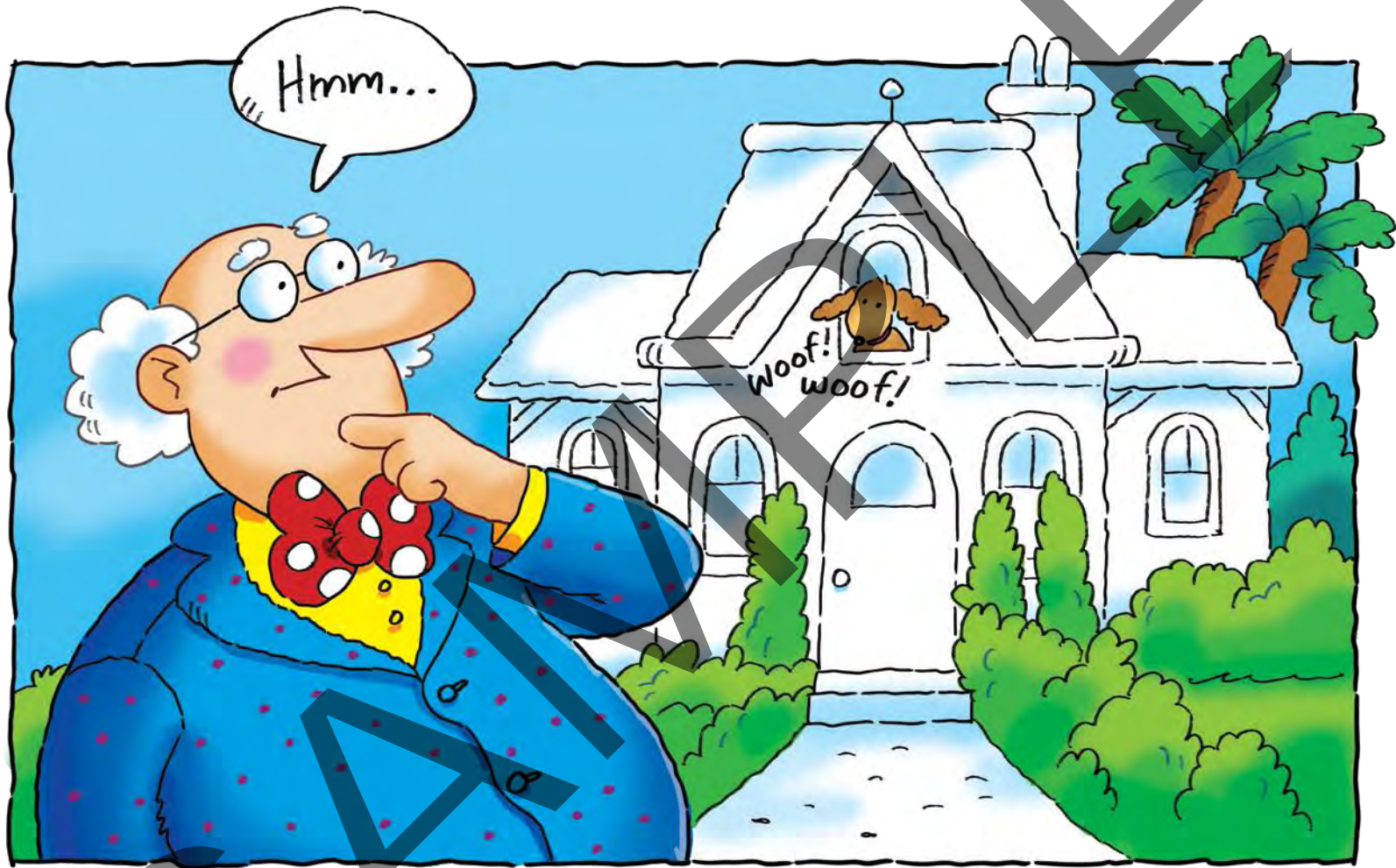


Mr. Noisy Paints His House

He paints his living room yellow. He paints his bedroom blue.</p> <p>Q2: How did Mr. Noisy make orange, green, and purple paint?</p> <p>A2: Mr. Noisy mixed red and yellow paint and made orange. He mixed blue and yellow paint and made green. He mixed red and blue paint and made purple.</p>	<p>Q1: Why did Mr. Noisy mix the paints?</p> <p>A1: Mr. Noisy mixed the paints because he loves orange, green, and purple.</p> <p>Q2: What did Mr. Noisy do with all the colors?</p> <p>A2: Mr. Noisy used all the colors to paint the outside of his house.</p>
