

Detective Dog and the Search for Cat

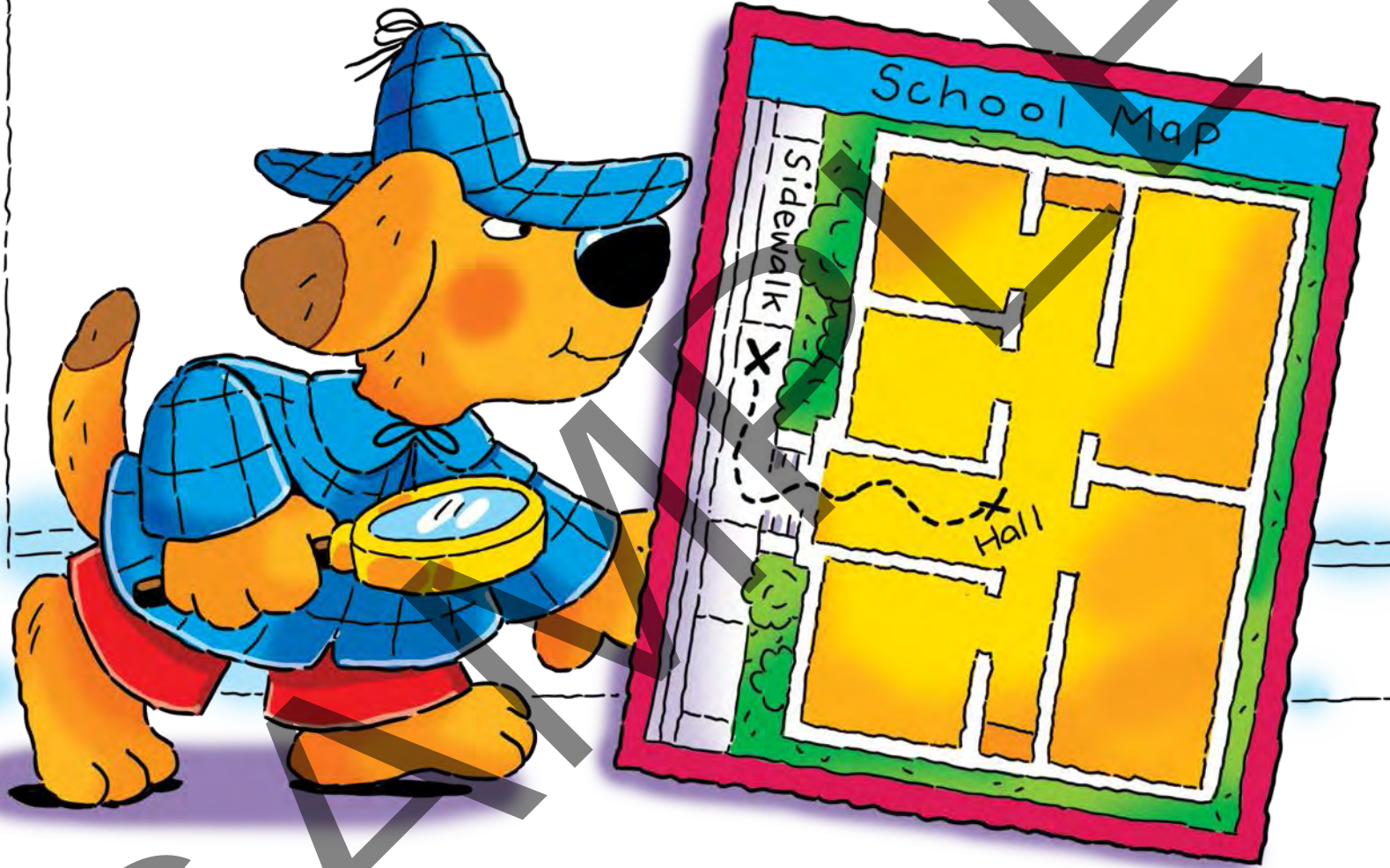

What does a detective do?</p> <p>A1: Possible answer: A detective looks for clues and tries to solve a mystery.</p> <p>Q2: What do you see on the cover and title page that might help Dog?</p> <p>A2: Dog has a magnifying glass. Dog is looking at footprints. Dog also has a map of the school.</p>	<p>Q1: Where does Dog go to look for Cat?</p> <p>A1: First, Dog went into the school, and stopped in the hall. Next, Dog went to the office, the library, and the cafeteria. Then Dog checked out the gym and the classroom.</p> <p>Q2: What school workers did Dog see?</p> <p>A2: Dog saw the janitor, the principal, the librarian, the cook, and the coach.</p>	<p>Q1: Where did Dog finally find Cat?</p> <p>A1: Dog found Cat in the classroom where children were painting.</p> <p>Q2: What two clues helped Dog?</p> <p>A2: First, Dog used the magnifying glass to look at the children's paintings. Their paintings were of an orange cat. Then, Dog saw a tail. It looked like Cat's tail!</p>
