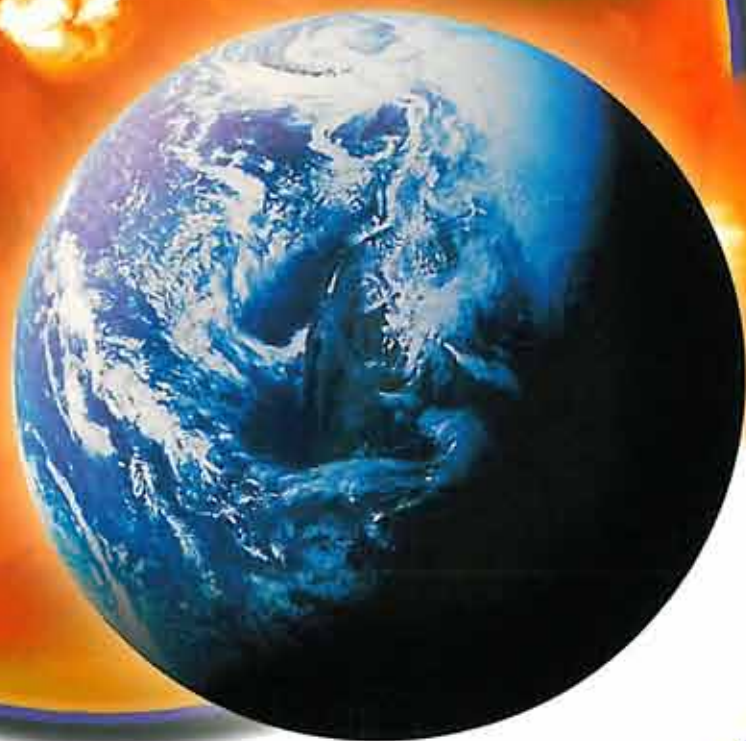

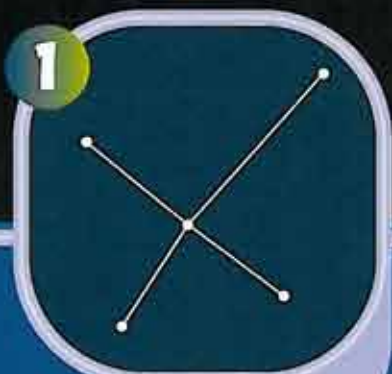

Orion

This diagram shows the constellation Orion. These stars only make this shape if you look at them from Earth. They are millions and millions of **light years** from each other.
