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| <p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at the cover. What do you see?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answers: I see a tree. I see a boy. I see a snowman. I see two birds. I see a brown squirrel. I see a rock. I see a river.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What season is it?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The season is winter.</p> | <p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at pages 4 and 5. These are pictures of the same place. What is different?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answers: The picture on page 4 shows that it is winter. The tree does not have leaves. There is snow everywhere. It looks cold! The picture on page 5 shows that it is summer. The tree has leaves and apples. Flowers are growing. The grass is green.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What are some things that are alive?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Possible answers: The turtle is alive. A tree is alive. Birds are alive. A boy is alive.</p> | <p><b>Q1:</b> Can you name some things that are not alive?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answers: A rock is not alive. A river is not alive. The boy's hat is not alive.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Look around the classroom. What things are alive or not alive?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Possible answers: Kids are alive. The teacher is alive. A pencil is not alive. The plant is alive. The goldfish is alive. A book is not alive. The spider is alive.</p> |
