Can you tell how they are grouped?</p> <p>A1: The red objects are mostly toys. The blue objects are things you would find in the kitchen. The yellow objects are things used for sewing.</p> <p>Q2: On pages 5-7, how are the green, orange, and purple objects grouped?</p> <p>A2: The green objects are fruits and vegetables. The orange objects are craft supplies and craft projects. The purple objects are things you find in nature.</p>	<p>Q1: Can you pick one page from the book and name each object you see?</p> <p>A1: Possible answer: Yes, I can! On page 2, I see red toys. I see a paper airplane, a toy airplane, a wagon, and a puzzle piece. I see a bow, a Lego piece, a balloon, a ball, and a car. I see a piggy bank too.</p> <p>Q2: Let's look at pages 2-8 again. Can you think of one more object that would go in each picture?</p> <p>A2: Possible answer: Yes, a red jump rope, a blue dinner plate, a yellow sewing basket, a green cucumber, orange construction paper, and purple grapes.</p>
