

# It's Melting!

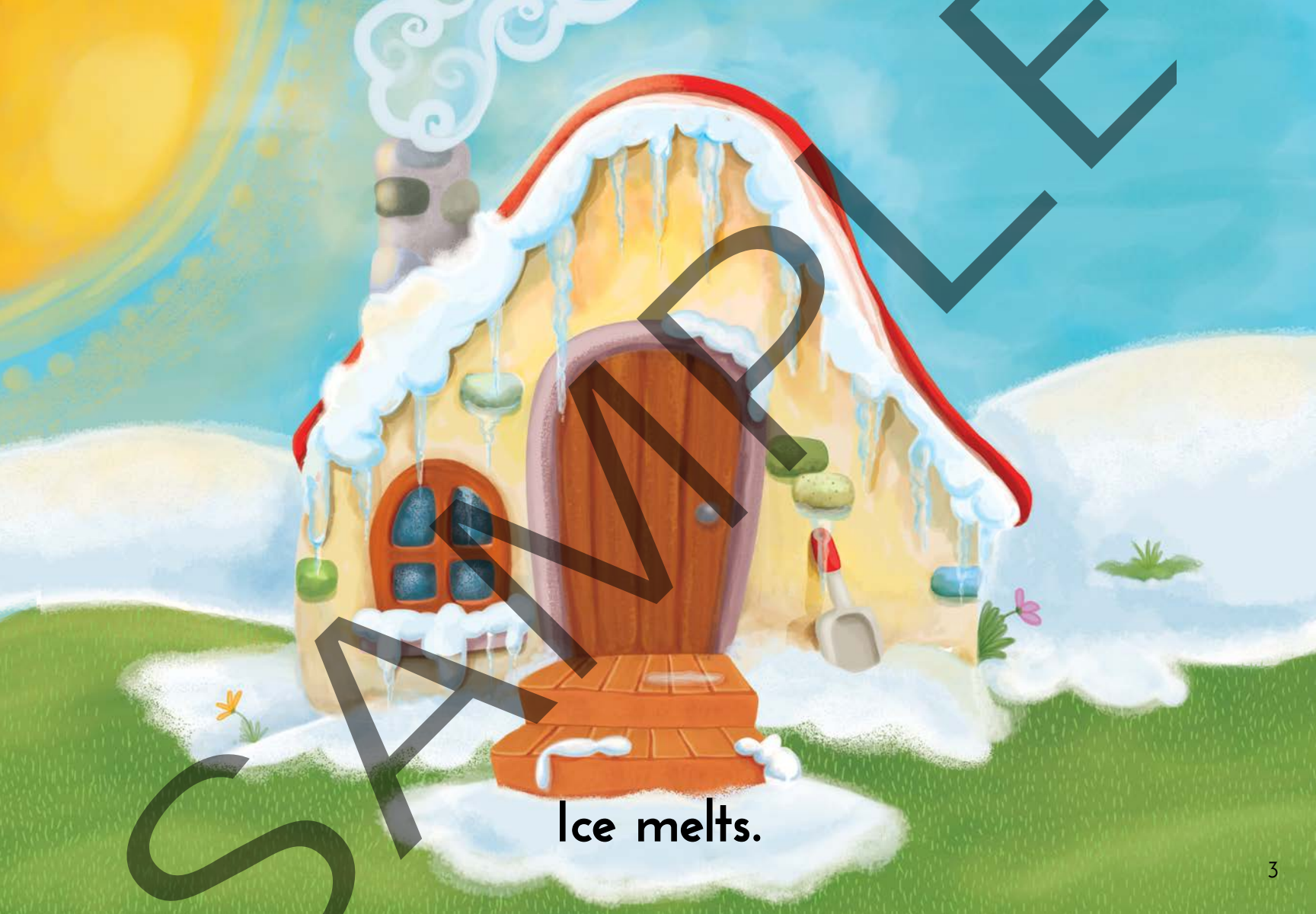

<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at the cover. What do you see?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answers: I see a girl. I see the sun. I see a dog. I see an ice-cream cone.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What is the weather?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The weather is sunny. It is hot.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What things melt in the sun?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Snow melts. Ice on the house melts. Butter melts. Candles melt. Crayons melt. Ice cream melts.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What makes the butter and the candles melt?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The butter melts on the warm toast. The candles melt from the flames.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Why do you think things melt?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> I think things melt because they get warm or hot.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Can you think of other things that melt?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Possible answers: Cheese melts on pizza. Marshmallows melt in hot chocolate. Chocolate melts in my pocket.</p>
