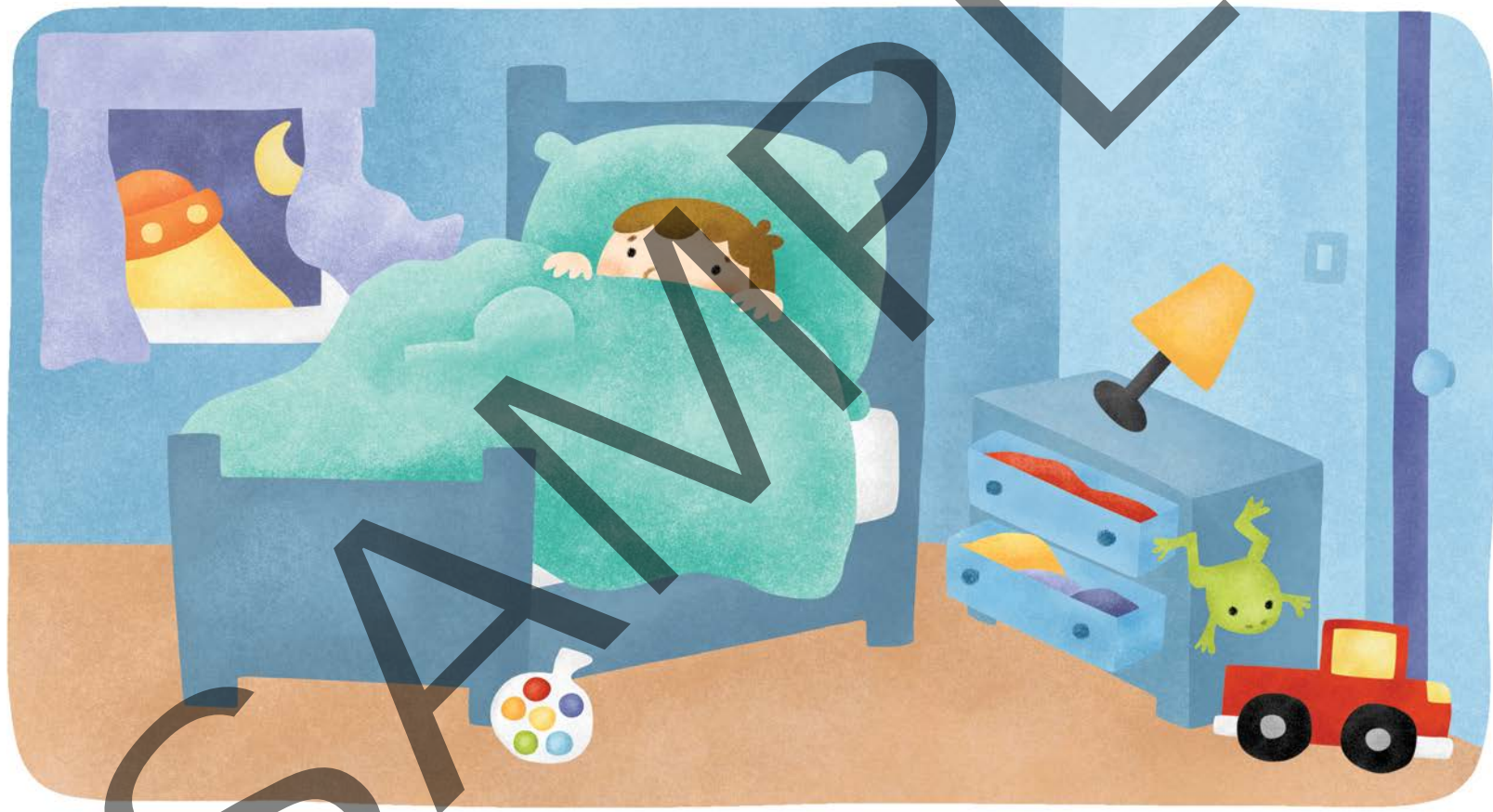
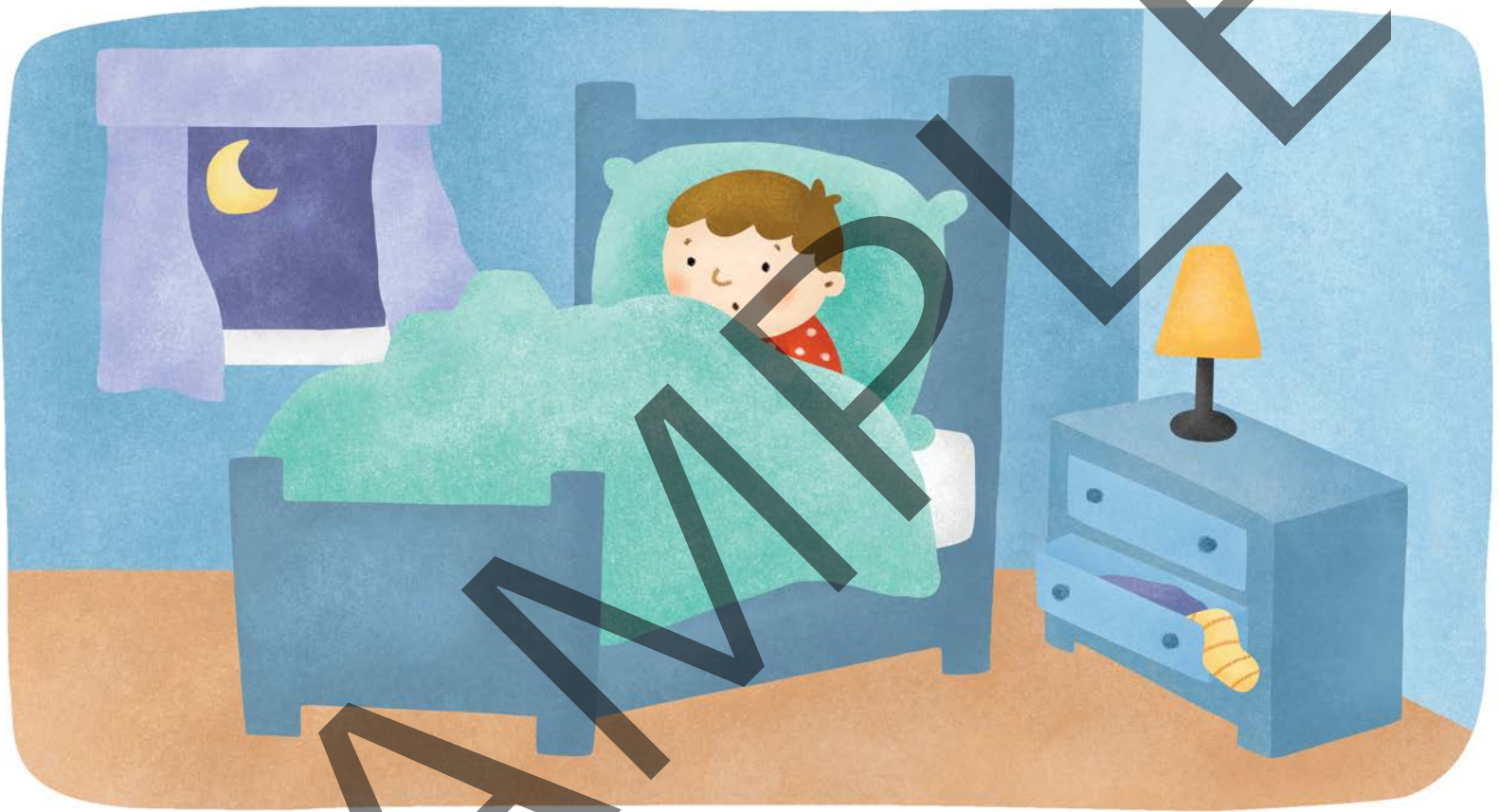


I Can't Sleep
