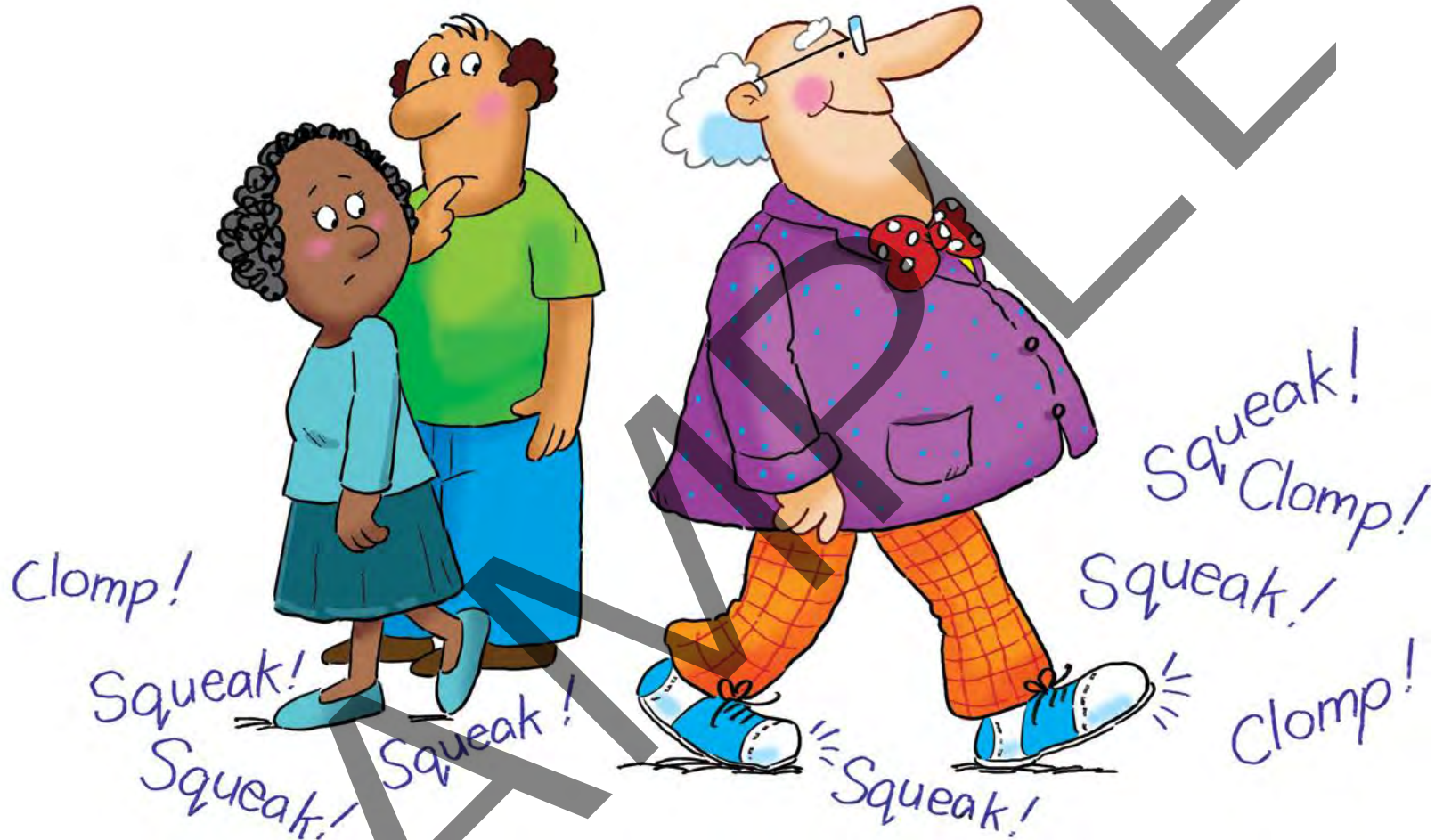


Mr. Noisy

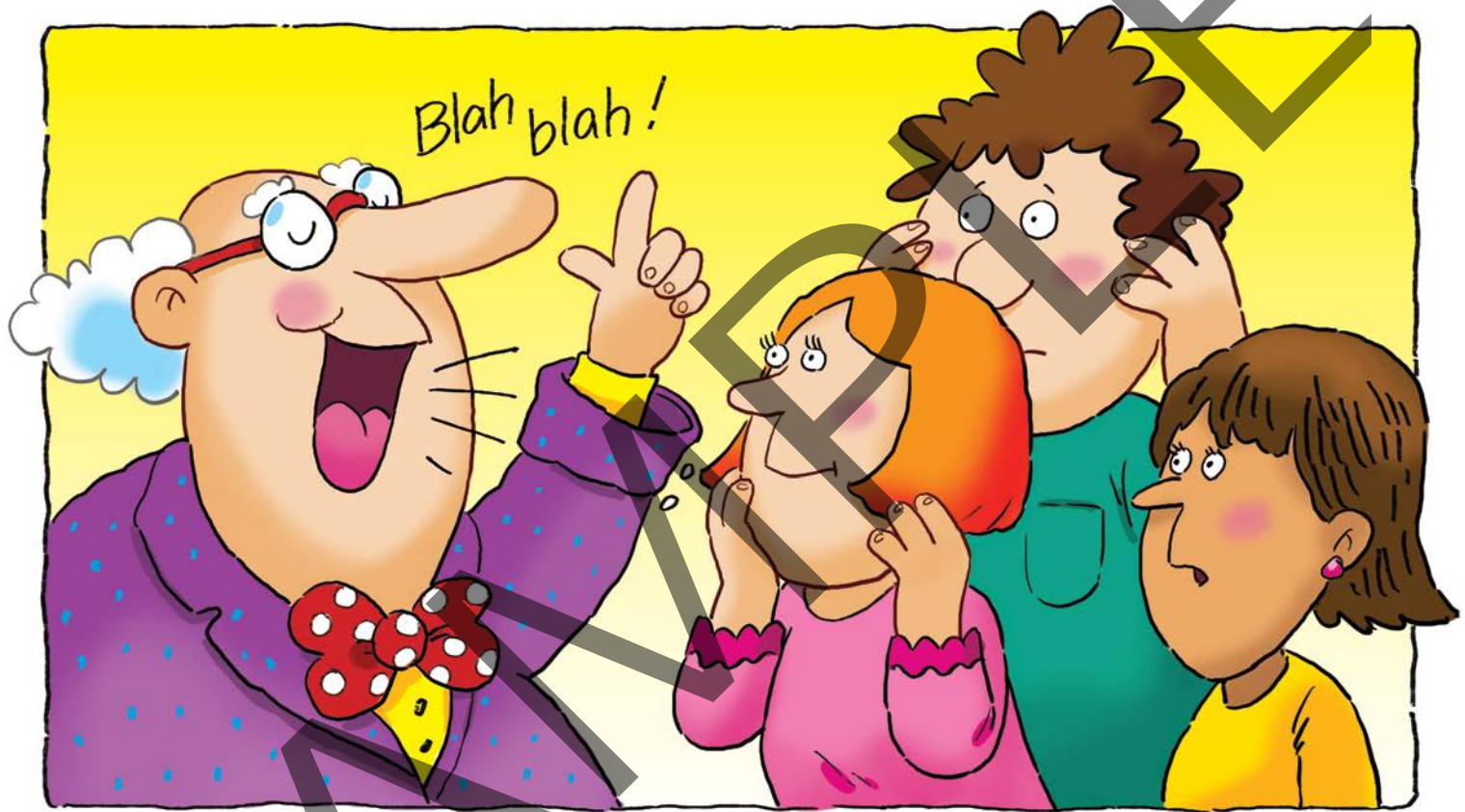

Blah, blah! Tap! Tap! Bang! Rattle! Honk! Ring!</i></p>	<p>Q1: What did everybody yell?</p> <p>A1: Everybody yelled, "It's too noisy!"</p> <p>Q2: How did the story end? Did Mr. Noisy become Mr. Quiet?</p> <p>A2: No, Mr. Noisy walked, talked, danced, and sang quietly. He did everything quietly. Everybody yelled, "It's too quiet!"
