Scaredy Cat could hide behind the tree.</p>	<p>Q1: Who did Scaredy Cat chase and then run away from?</p> <p>A1: Scaredy Cat chased and then ran away from the mouse, the rabbit, the spider, and the bird.</p> <p>Q2: What were the animals doing when they saw Scaredy Cat?</p> <p>A2: The mouse was planting a flower. The rabbit was picking carrots. The spider was spinning a web. The bird was flying.</p>	<p>Q1: Let's look at pages 10 and 16. How are these pictures different?</p> <p>A1: On page 10, Scaredy Cat is hiding in the tree. Scaredy Cat looks sad and afraid. The bird, the mouse, the spider, and the rabbit look mad. On page 16, all the animals are smiling and happy.</p> <p>Q2: How did all the animals become friends again?</p> <p>A2: They stopped chasing each other and started talking to each other.
