One child is wearing a butterfly costume. One child is wearing a green monster costume. One child is wearing a ghost costume. One child is wearing a bear costume.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What are the children doing?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> The children are having a costume parade. Every costume has a special place in the parade.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> In what order are the children walking? Who is first, second, etc.?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The clown is first. The ghost is second. The butterfly is third. The monster is fourth. The bear is fifth.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Which costume wins the prize?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> All the costumes win a prize.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What are the prizes?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The bear is the fuzziest costume. The ghost is the scariest costume. The butterfly is the prettiest costume. The monster is the ugliest costume. The clown is the funniest costume.</p>
