

Ten Monsters in a Bed

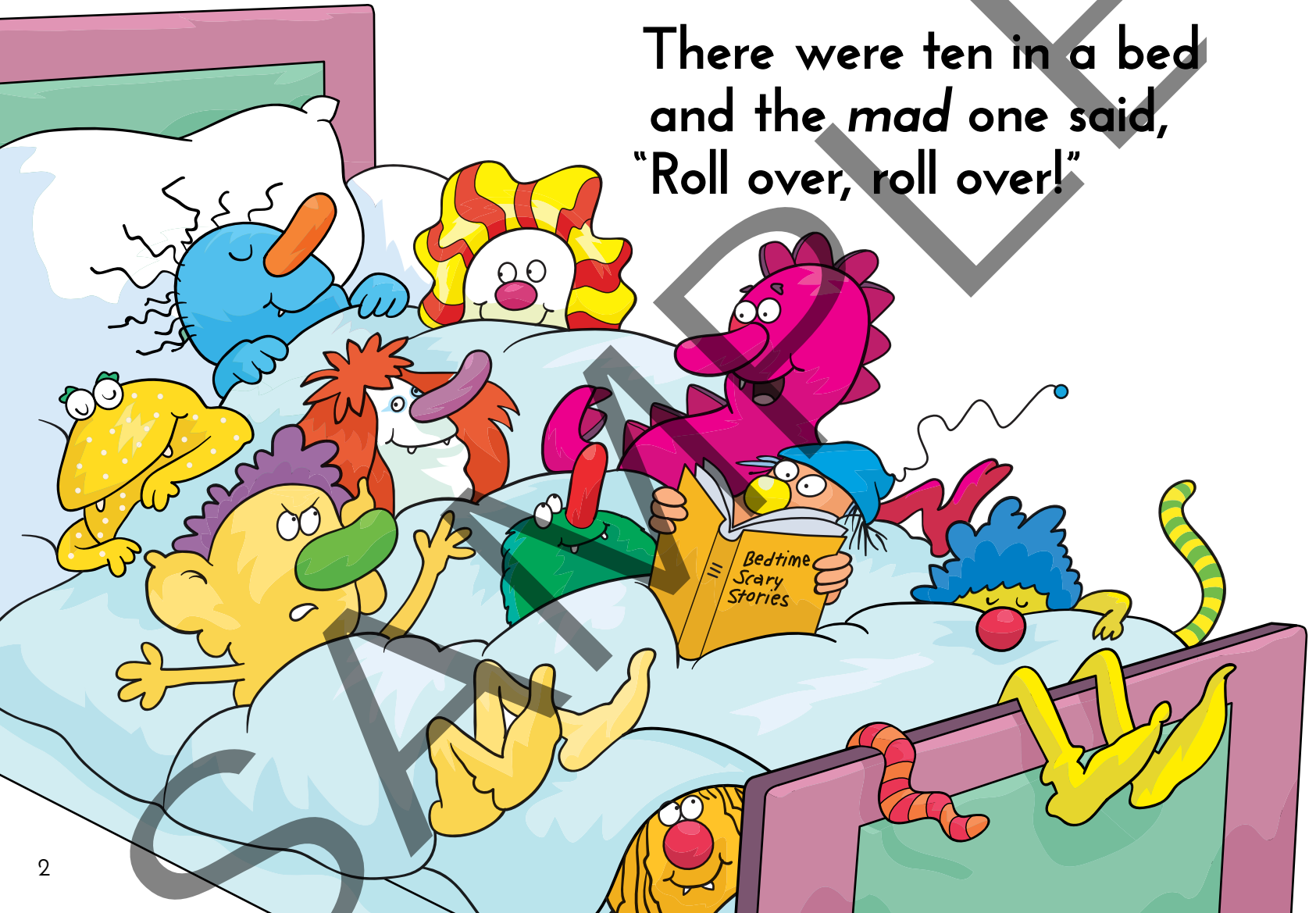

<p>Q1: Let's look at the cover. How many characters do you see?</p> <p>A1: I see eleven characters. I see ten funny monsters and one silly spider.</p> <p>Q2: What are the characters doing?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: A yellow monster is waving. One monster is sleeping. A monster with a cap is reading a book. Another monster is hiding.</p>	<p>Q1: What happens to the monsters?</p> <p>A1: Possible answers: The ten monsters were in the bed. Every time they roll over, one falls out!</p> <p>Q2: What is the spider doing?</p> <p>A2: The spider holds up a card with a math sentence. It shows how many monsters are in the bed after one falls out.</p>	<p>Q1: How many monsters were left in the bed at the end of the story?</p> <p>A1: One striped monster was left in the bed.</p> <p>Q2: What did the striped monster say?</p> <p>A2: The striped monster said, "Good night!"</p>

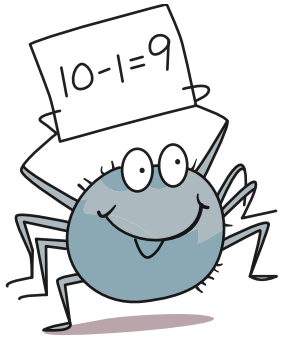
Sing the story to the tune of "There Were Ten in the Bed."
