What are some of the things we will be counting?</p> <p>A2: We will be counting bugs, frogs, cats, foxes, hens, bees, goats, and bears.</p> | <p>Q1: How many bugs, frogs, cats, and foxes can you count?</p> <p>A1: I can count five bugs, four frogs, six cats, and two foxes.</p> <p>Q2: How many hens, bees, goats, and bears can you count?</p> <p>A2: I can count nine hens, seven bees, eight goats, and ten bears.</p> | <p>Q1: What words rhyme in this counting song?</p> <p>A1: The rhyming words are: <i>bugs on rugs, frogs on logs, cats on mats, foxes in boxes, hens in pens, bees in trees, goats in boats, and bears in chairs.</i></p> <p>Q2: Can you think of a new verse for this counting song?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: <i>We'll count the ants and put them on plants; We'll count the whales and count their tails; We'll count the fishes and put them on dishes; We'll count the dogs and put them on logs . . . And then we'll let them go!</i></p> |
