<p>Q1: Let's look at the cover and read the title. What do you see in the picture?</p> <p>A1: I see a brown dog, an orange cat, and a green turtle. I see a white rabbit. The white rabbit is a magician. I see a little blue bird. I see a big magic box.</p> <p>Q2: What do you think this story will be about?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: I think the rabbit will do magic tricks using the box. I think that the magician rabbit will make magic money appear.</p>	<p>Q1: What kind of money "magic" does the rabbit perform?</p> <p>A1: The magician rabbit makes one nickel from five pennies. He makes a dime from five pennies and one nickel. He makes a quarter from two dimes and a nickel.</p> <p>Q2: What does the magician rabbit make from two quarters?</p> <p>A2: He makes a half-dollar from two quarters.</p>	<p>Q1: How does the magician rabbit make one dollar?</p> <p>A1: The magician rabbit makes one dollar by putting twenty pennies, one nickel, one quarter, and five dimes into the magic money box.</p> <p>Q2: Can you think of others ways to make one dollar?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: Yes! Four quarters make one dollar. Ten dimes make one dollar. Twenty nickels make one dollar.</p>
