

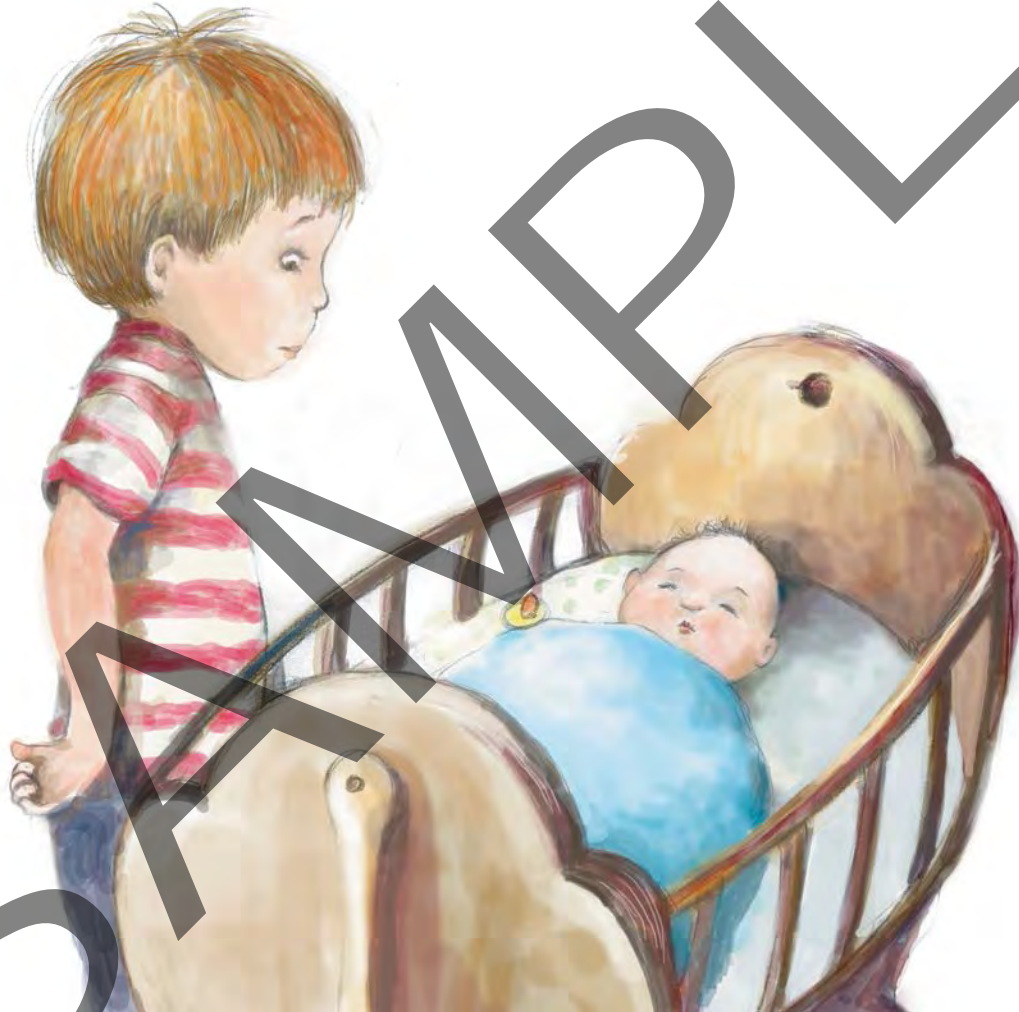
# I Have a New Baby Brother

<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at the picture on the cover and read the title. Do you think the little boy is happy to get a new baby brother?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answers: He is looking at his baby brother. He looks like he is not sure if he is happy. He is thinking about what is going on.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What is the little boy going to do with all his toy animals?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Possible answers: I think the little boy will hide with his animals. I think the little boy will let the baby play with the animals.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What pets or baby wild animals did the little boy want?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> The little boy wanted a puppy or kitten. He wanted a bear cub or a tiger cub. He wanted an elephant calf or a walrus calf. He wanted a wolf pup or a seal pup.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What farm animals or zoo animals did the little boy want?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The little boy wanted a lamb, a piglet, or a duckling. He wanted a zebra colt or a kangaroo joey.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Did the little boy get a "joey"?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Yes! He got a new baby brother named Joey.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> At the ending of the story, how did the little boy feel about his baby brother.</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Possible answers: The little boy was happy when he got to hold little Joey. He was happy to have a new baby brother.</p>
