Maybe Dog is calling their friends.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What did Cat and Dog put in the snack bowl?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Cat put in a cup of raisins and Dog put in a cup of peanuts. Then, they mixed it all up.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What did their friends put in the snack bowl?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Mouse put in a cup of pretzels. Kitten put in a cup of crackers. Then, they mixed it all up!</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What made the snack better than before?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answer: The snack was better when more things were added.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> How did all the friends share the super snack?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> They each took a cup, and divided it up!</p>

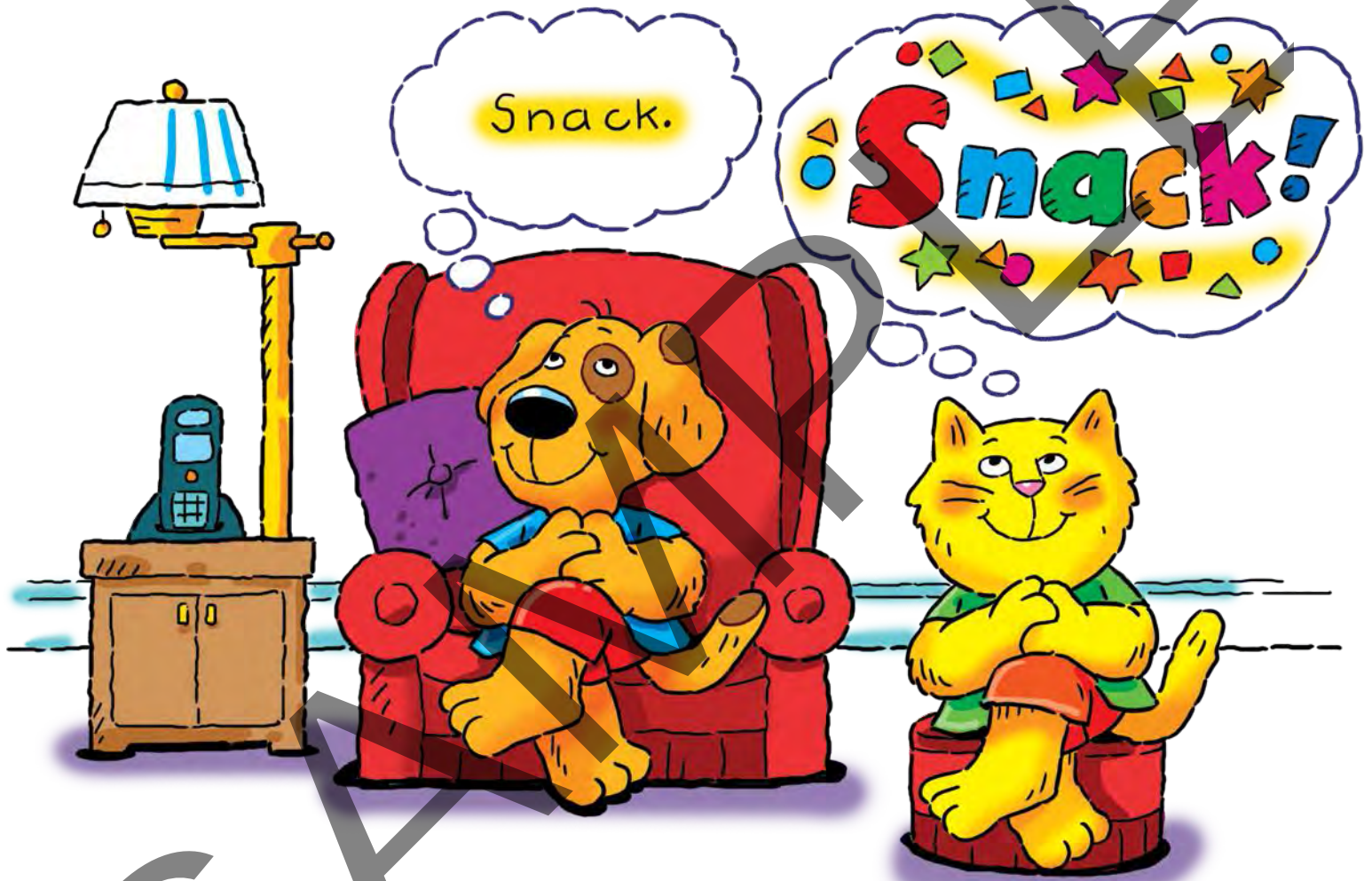
