<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at the cover and read the title. How many dinosaurs are dancing on the cover?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> On the cover, there are three dinosaurs dancing.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Can you describe the three dinosaurs?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> There is one big, green dinosaur. The one in the middle is red. The little dinosaur is blue. All three dinosaurs are wearing fancy clothes.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Where are the three, four, and five dinosaurs dancing?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Three dinosaurs are dancing under a tree. Four dinosaurs are dancing out the kitchen door. Five dinosaurs are dancing around a beehive.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What are the six dinosaurs doing?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The six dinosaurs are dancing and doing tricks.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Look at the pictures on the cover, on the title page, and on page 16. Can you write a little story about the three dinosaurs?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Possible answer: Yes! Three dinosaurs are dancing together. The big green dinosaur dances alone. The big green dinosaur takes a bow and bumps the blue dinosaur. The red dinosaur is mad!</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> How many different dinosaurs can you count in the book?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> I can count 58 different dinosaurs in the book!</p>
