

# If Animals Came to School

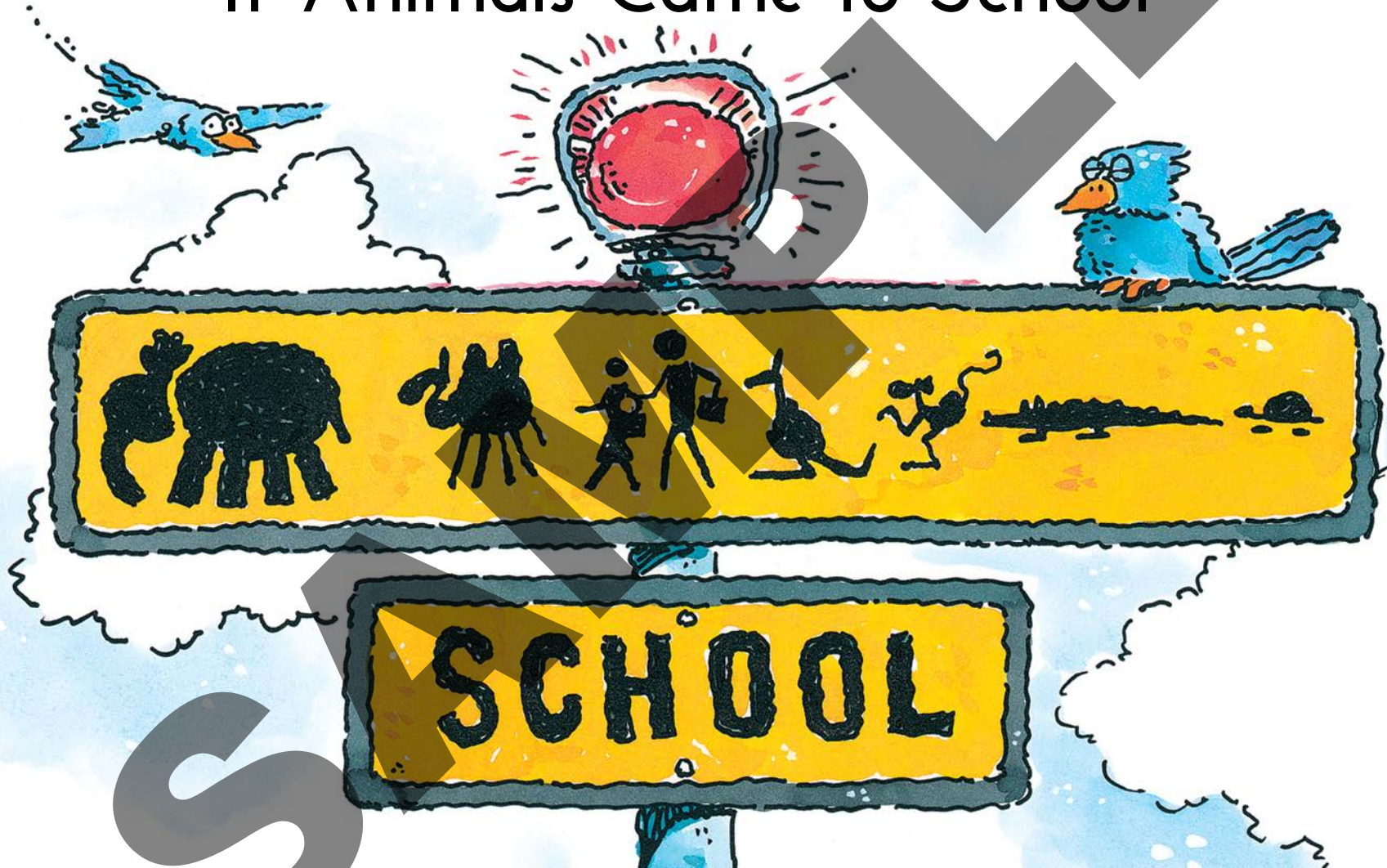

<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at the cover and read the title. What animals do you see coming to school?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> I see an elephant, an alligator, and a turtle. I see a kangaroo, a camel, and a monkey.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What are the funny animals doing?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Some animals are reading or carrying books. A turtle is carrying an apple.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What problems would happen if animals came to school?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Art class would be messy. Story time would be crowded, and lunch-time would be busy. Races would be slow. Going to the library would be a problem, and music class would be noisy.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What would be fun?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Recess would be fun. Lining up and field trips would be fun. Playing Hide and Seek would be fun. Leaving the library and clean-up time would be fun.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> What "animals" sometimes come to school?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> Yes, we sometimes wear animal masks at school.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> Do animals ever come to <i>your</i> school?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Answers will vary: Some classrooms have pets. Our class has a pet bunny. We have Pet Day at our school. Our class put on a play, and we wore animal costumes. We have stuffed animals in the reading corner.</p>

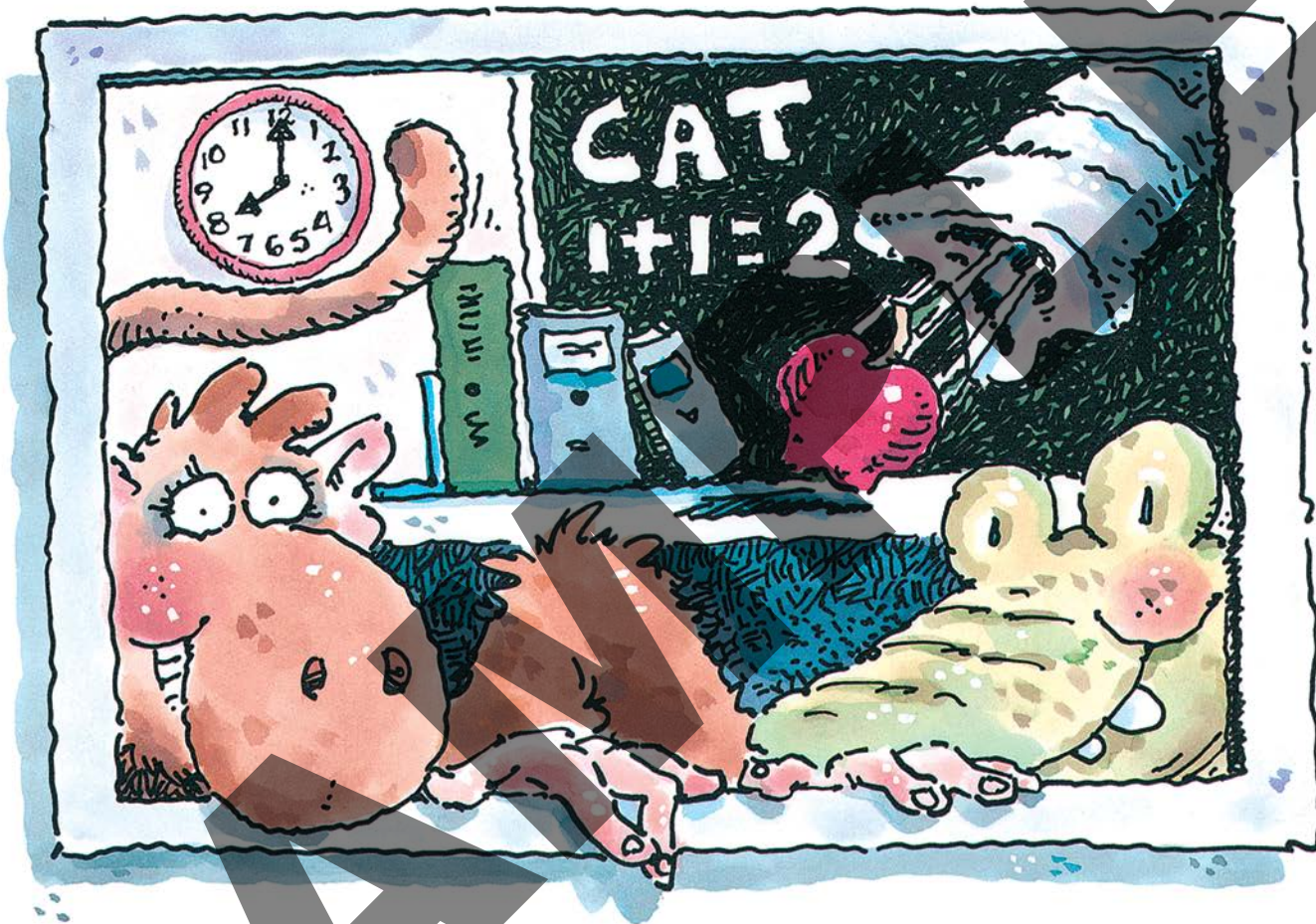

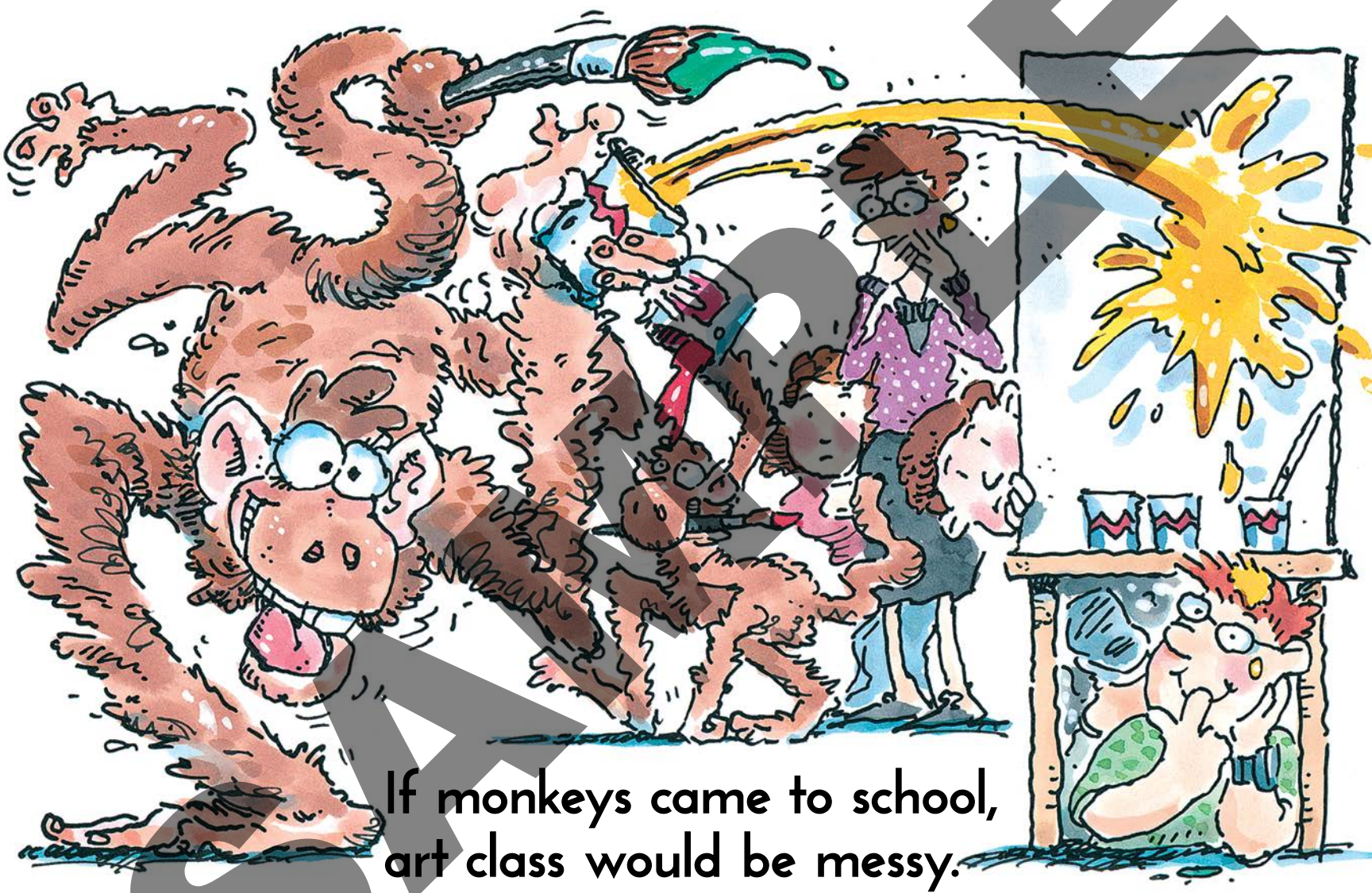
