<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's read the title and look at the cover and title page. How do you think this story begins?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> I see the hungry farmer. He would like to make toast in his toaster. He wants to put butter and honey on his toast. But the farmer is out of bread. His dog looks surprised too.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What do you think the farmer will do?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> Answers will vary: I think the farmer will make some bread. I think the farmer will go to the store. I think the farmer will eat eggs or pancakes instead.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Where does the farmer go?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> First, the farmer goes to the store. Next, he goes to find the truck. Then he goes to the bakery and the mill. Finally, he finds himself back at his farm.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> What did the farmer have to do?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The farmer had to harvest the grain. Then the miller could make flour from the grain. With the flour, the baker could make bread. Then the truck driver could deliver the bread to the store. Finally, the farmer could buy the bread.</p>	<p><b>Q1:</b> Let's look at page 16. The farmer and his friends are eating some bread. How did they get the bread?</p> <p><b>A1:</b> First, the farmer had to harvest the grain. Then the miller had to make the grain into flour. Then the baker made the bread from the flour.</p> <p><b>Q2:</b> How did the bread get to the store?</p> <p><b>A2:</b> The truck delivered the bread to the grocer at his store.</p>

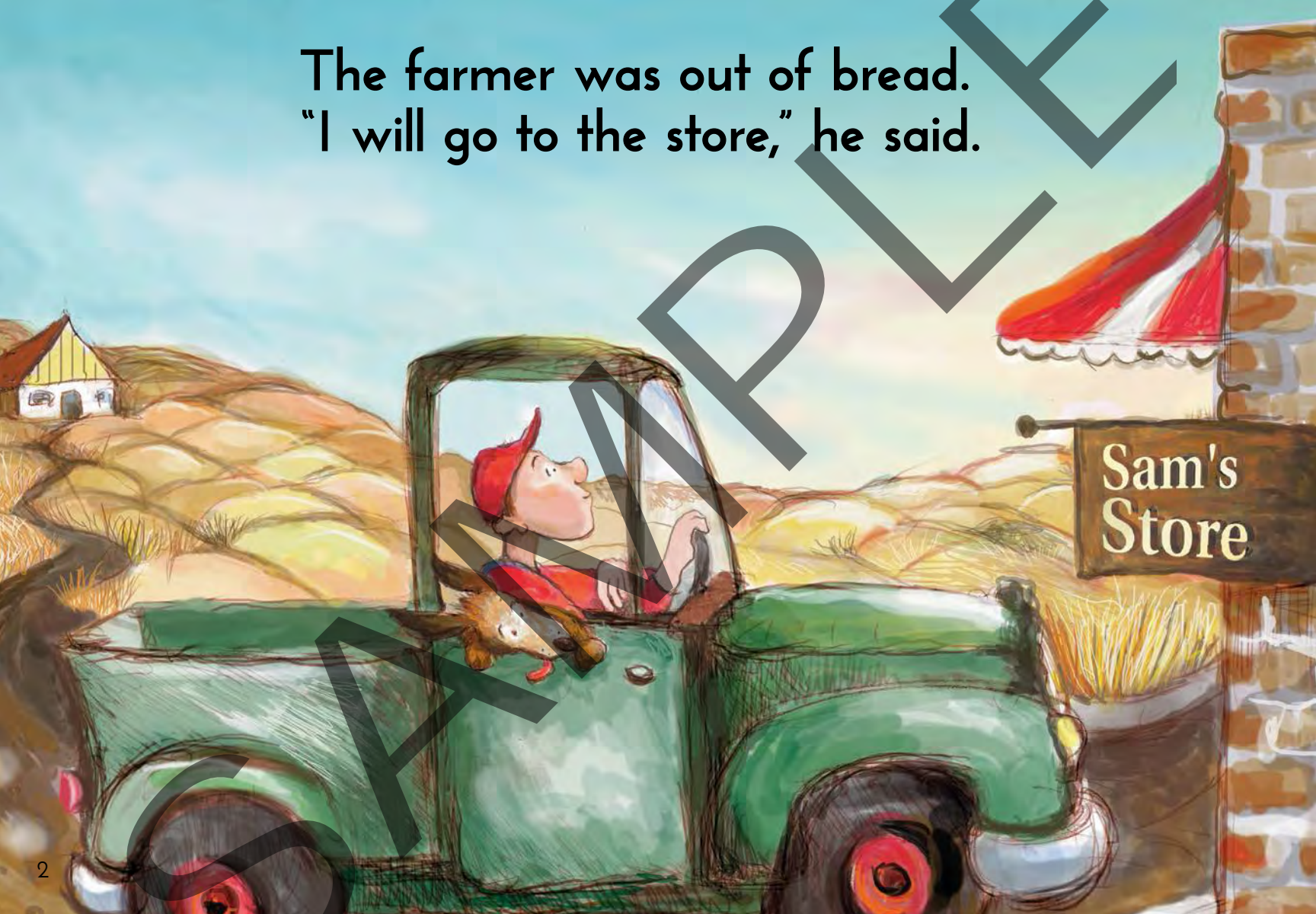
