Cat has a special hat and a whistle. Dog has a clipboard with the Playground Rules.</p>	<p>Q1: What rules do Cat and Dog help the kids follow?</p> <p>A1: The rules are: Play fair. Talk things over. Do not climb the fence. Only kick soccer balls. Be careful when walking near the swings. Go feet first down the slide.</p> <p>Q2: Why did Dog have to talk to Cat?</p> <p>A2: Cat forgot and was walking up the slide. Cat should sit on the slide and go down feet first.</p>	<p>Q1: Why is recess more fun when everyone follows the rules?</p> <p>A1: Possible answers: Recess is more fun because everyone gets along. Everyone stays safe. Everyone gets a turn. No one fights and gets hurt.</p> <p>Q2: What are some rules you have on your playground?</p> <p>A2: Possible answers: Take turns with the equipment and at the water fountain. No dogs allowed. Be polite and helpful.</p>
