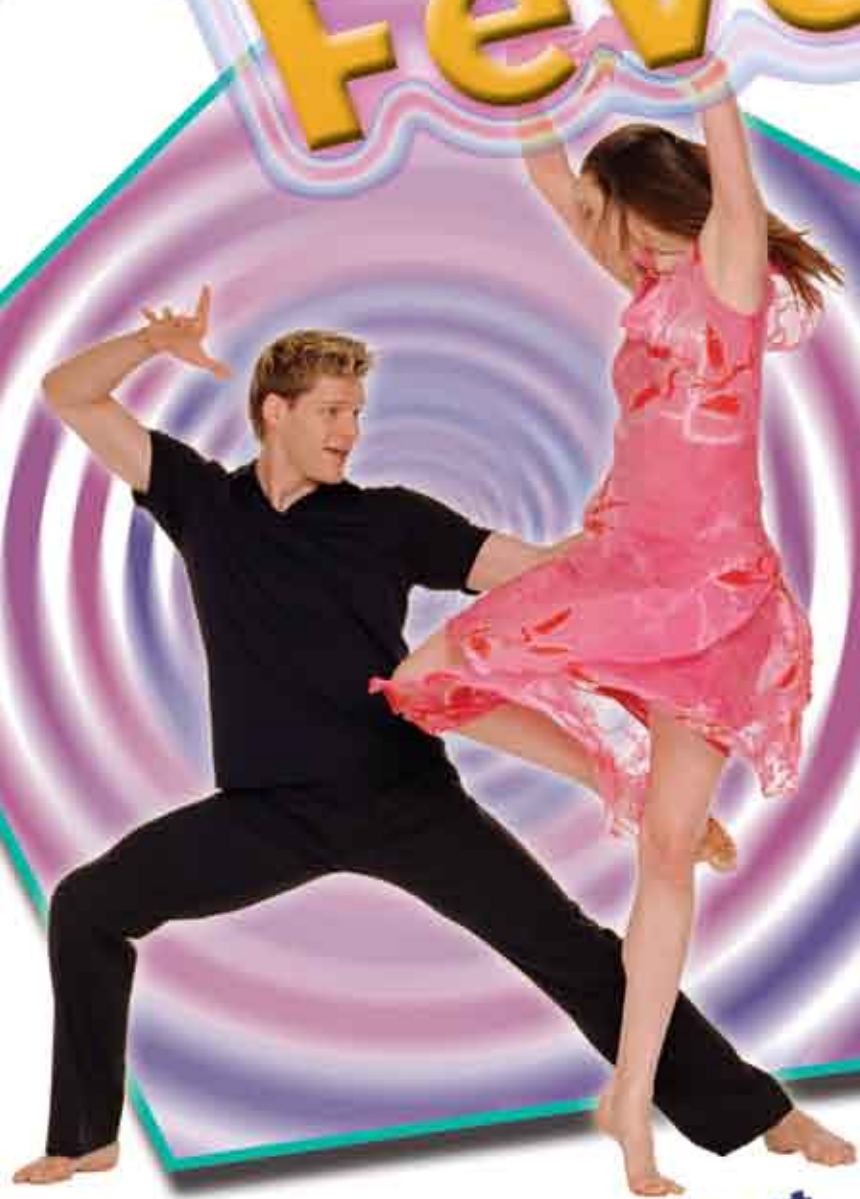

The world's largest disco dance was held in New York in 1979, with 13,000 disco dancers in 1 room.

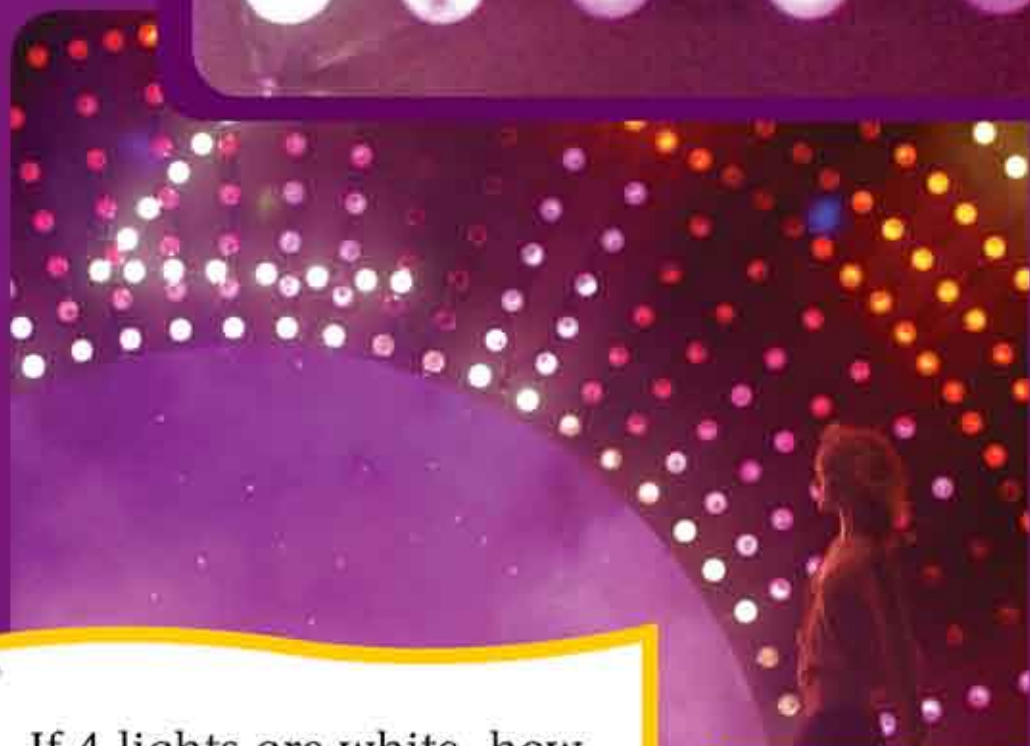
