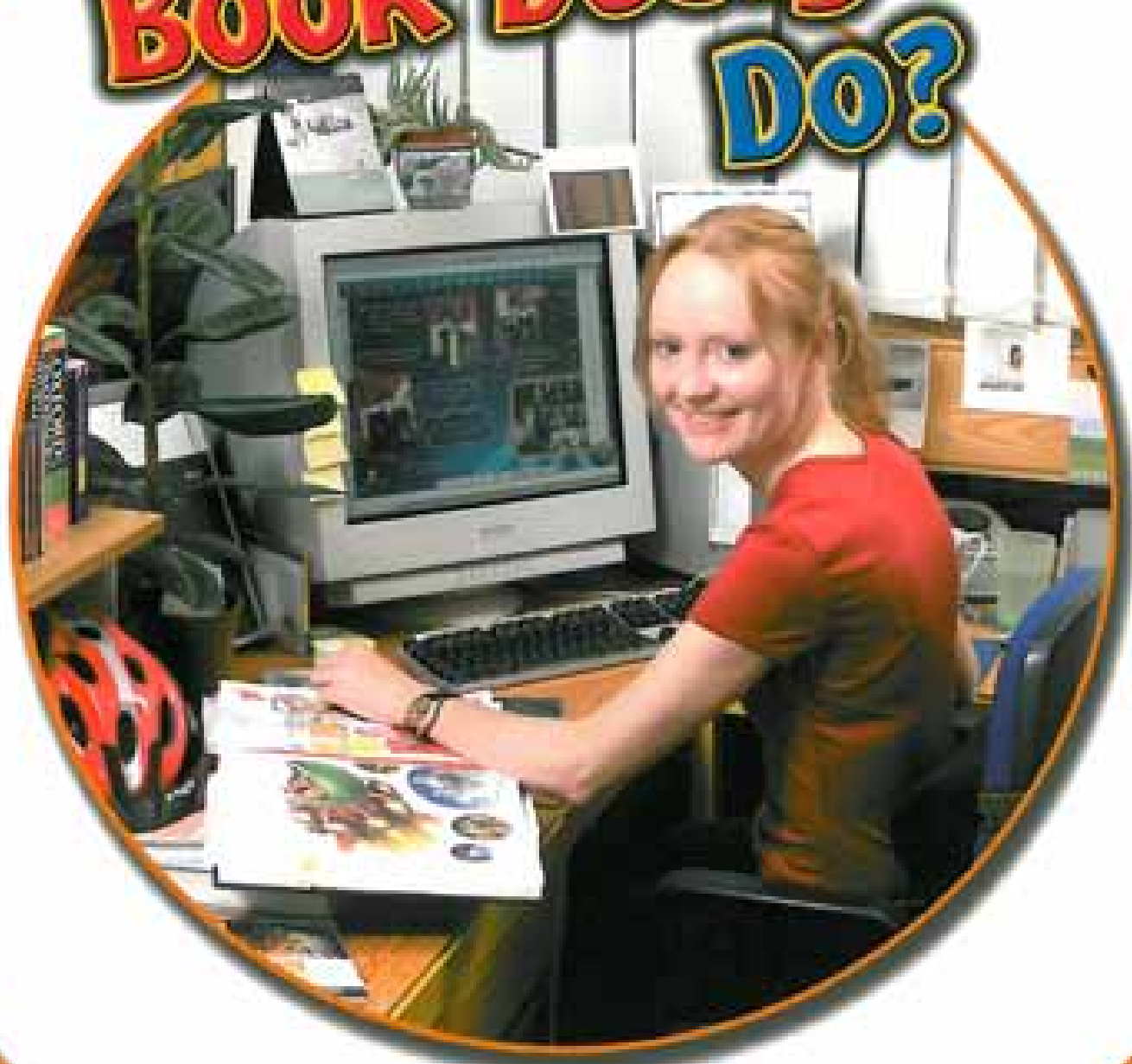




## JARGON

Jargon: the words and phrases that mean special things in a job

## JARGON

**Editor:** the person who reviews something someone else has written, suggesting changes and ways to make it better



## JARGON

**Author:** the person who writes the book

## JARGON

**Art:** all the drawings or photos that go into a book
