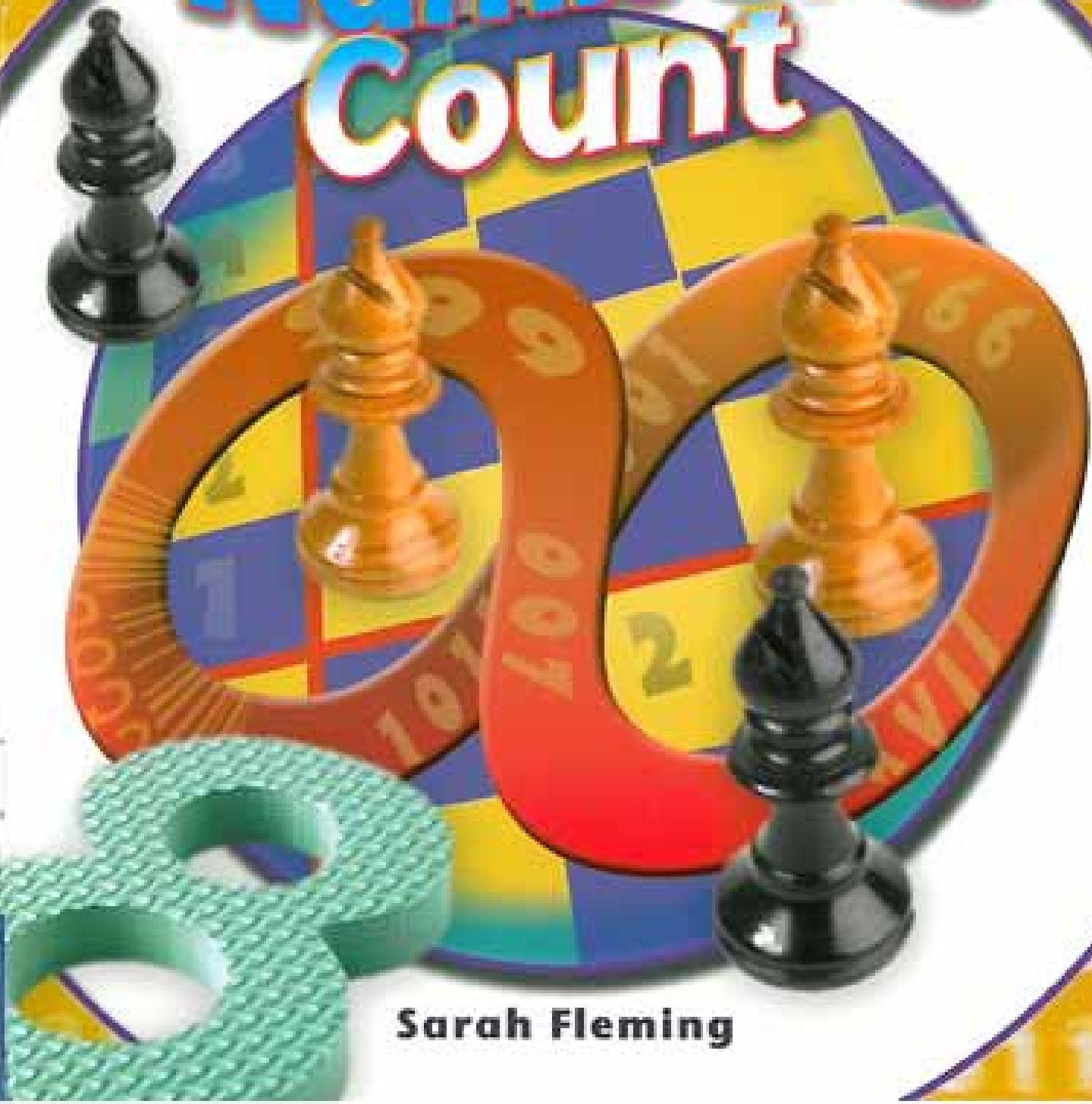

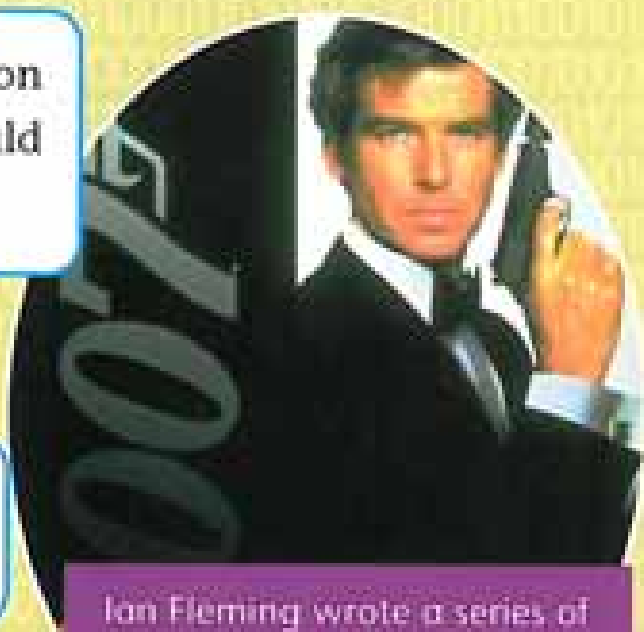


Special Numbers

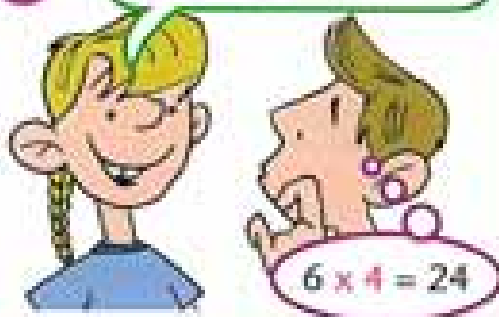

Multiply it by 4.



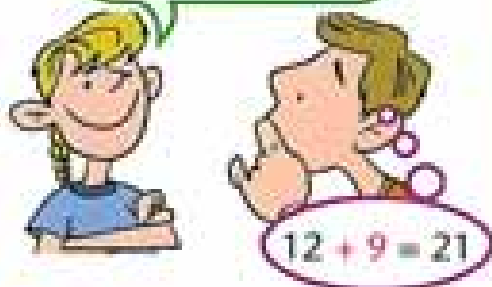
C
