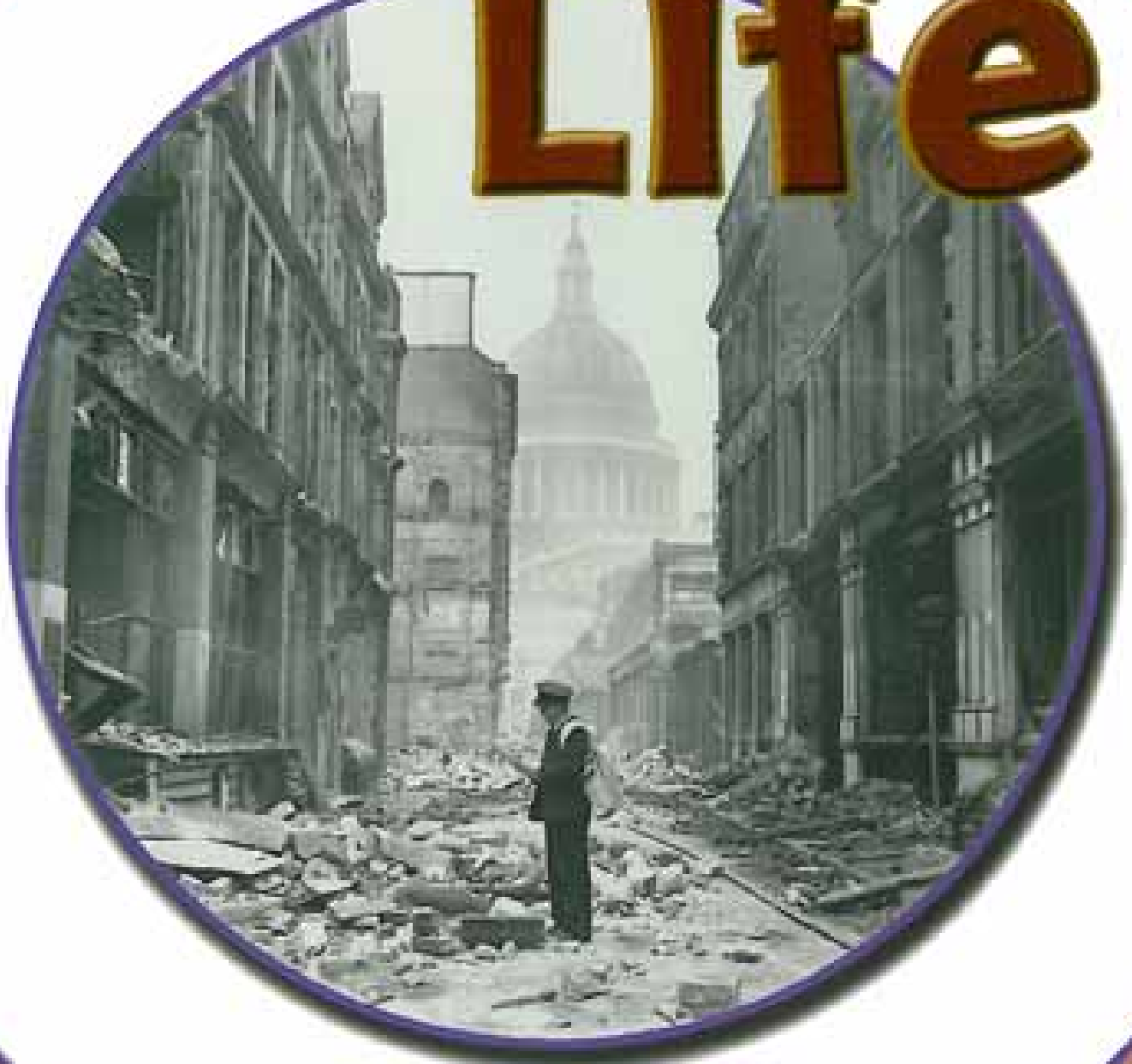

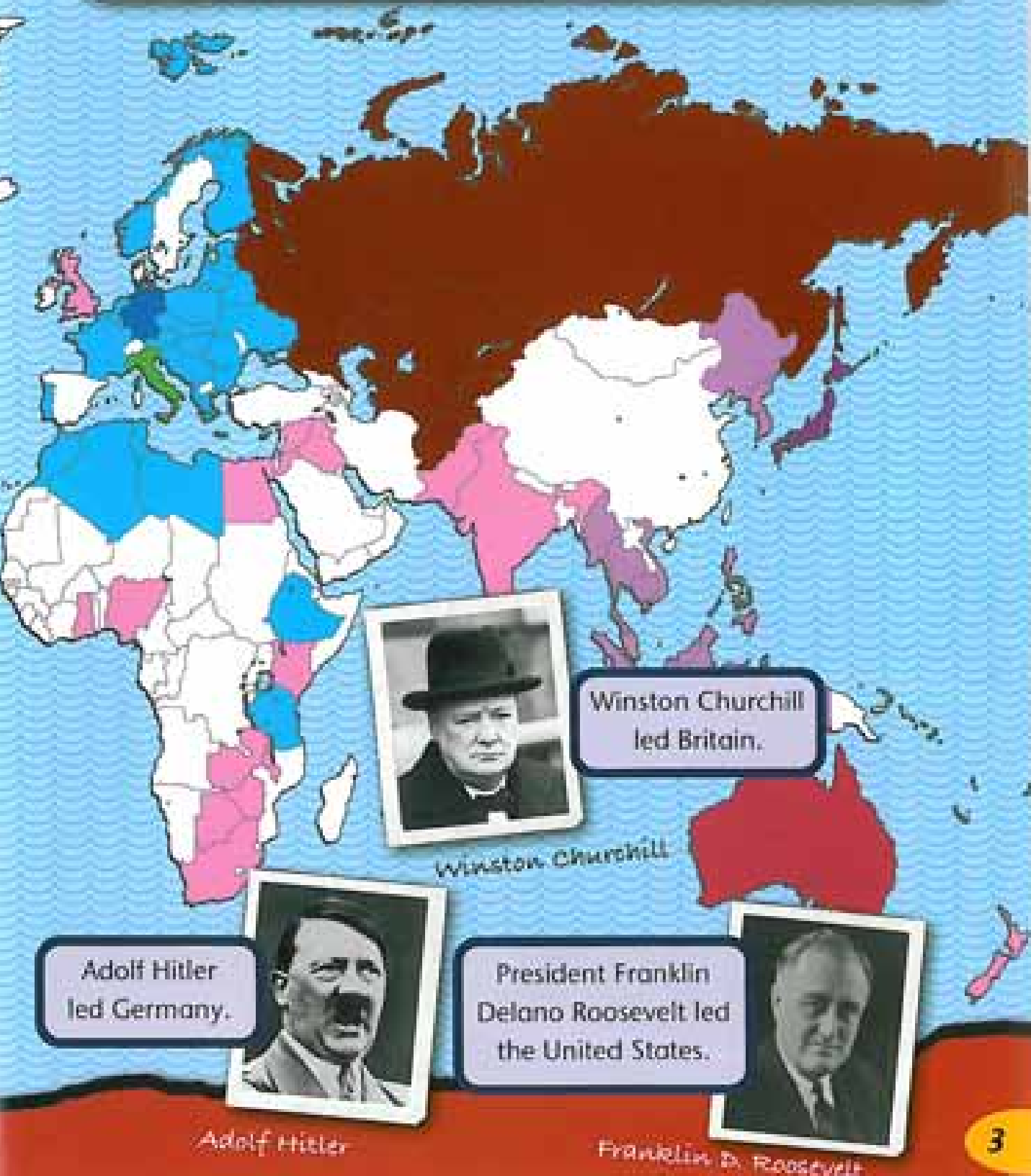


The World at War

Winston Churchill led Britain.

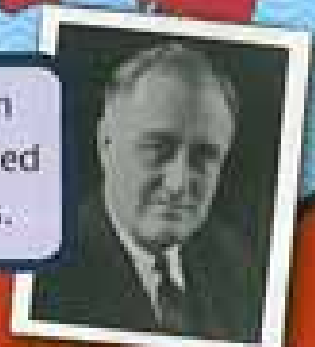
