







The fact that most atolls are circular tells you a lot about how they form. Imagine an underwater volcano rising slowly from the ocean floor, over thousands of years. Eventually, it reaches the surface and becomes an island. In American Samoa, an underwater volcano called Vailuluu (Vy-loo-loo-oo) is growing toward the ocean's surface.

With only 1,935 feet (590 meters) to go, it will probably rise above the ocean in just a few hundred years.
